<b>Present Simple =&gt; Past Simple</b>	
<p><i>He answered, "I want to go to the theatre."</i> — Он ответил: «Я хочу пойти в театр».</p> <p><i>He said, "I am hungry!"</i> — Он сказал: «Я голоден!»</p>	<p><i>He answered that he wanted to go to the theatre. (Он ответил, что хочет пойти в театр).</i></p> <p><i>He said that he was hungry</i> — Он сказал, что он голоден.</p>
<b>Present Continuous =&gt; Past Continuous</b>	
<p><i>Jim said, "I'm doing English exercises now."</i> — Джим сказал: «Сейчас я делаю упражнения по английскому языку».</p> <p><i>Mother said, "I am cooking the dinner now."</i> — Мама сказала: «Я сейчас готовлю обед».</p>	<p><i>Jim said that he was doing English exercises then. — Джим сказал, что он делает упражнения по английскому языку.</i></p> <p><i>Mother said that she was cooking the dinner then — Мама сказала, что она готовила обед</i></p>
<b>Present Perfect =&gt; Past Perfect</b>	
<p><i>My son said, "I have read the book twice."</i> — Мой сын сказал: «Я дважды читал эту книгу».</p> <p><i>She said, "I have worked hard today."</i> — Она сказала: «Я много работала сегодня».</p>	<p><i>My son said that he had read the book twice. — Мой сын сказал, что он дважды читал эту книгу.</i></p> <p><i>She said that she had worked hard that day</i> — Она сказала, что она много работала в тот день.</p>
