Ella A lot? Has he shaved his head?

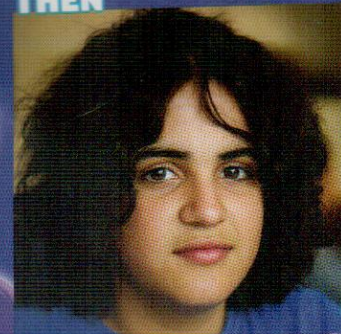

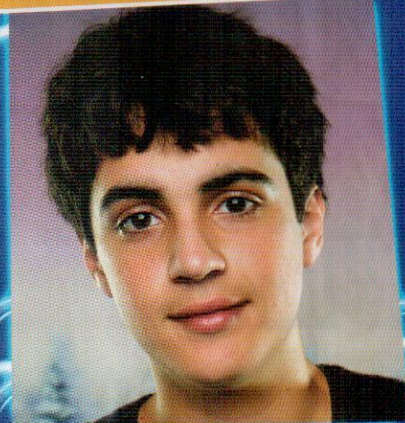

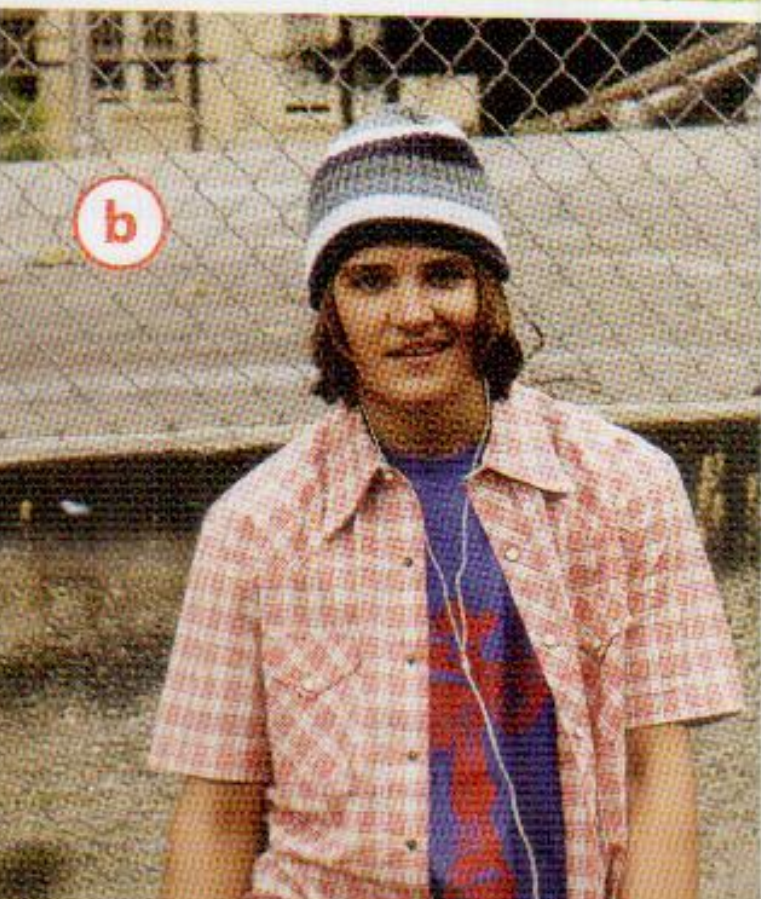

We're in Manchester to find out about different groups of young people.



1 **Skaters** love skateboarding. They wear baggy jeans, T-shirts and trainers – but they don't do up their shoelaces. They sometimes wear a woollen hat or a baseball cap back to front. Max says, 'All my friends are Skaters. We listen to music when we do skateboard tricks.'
