We watch tv in the afternoon



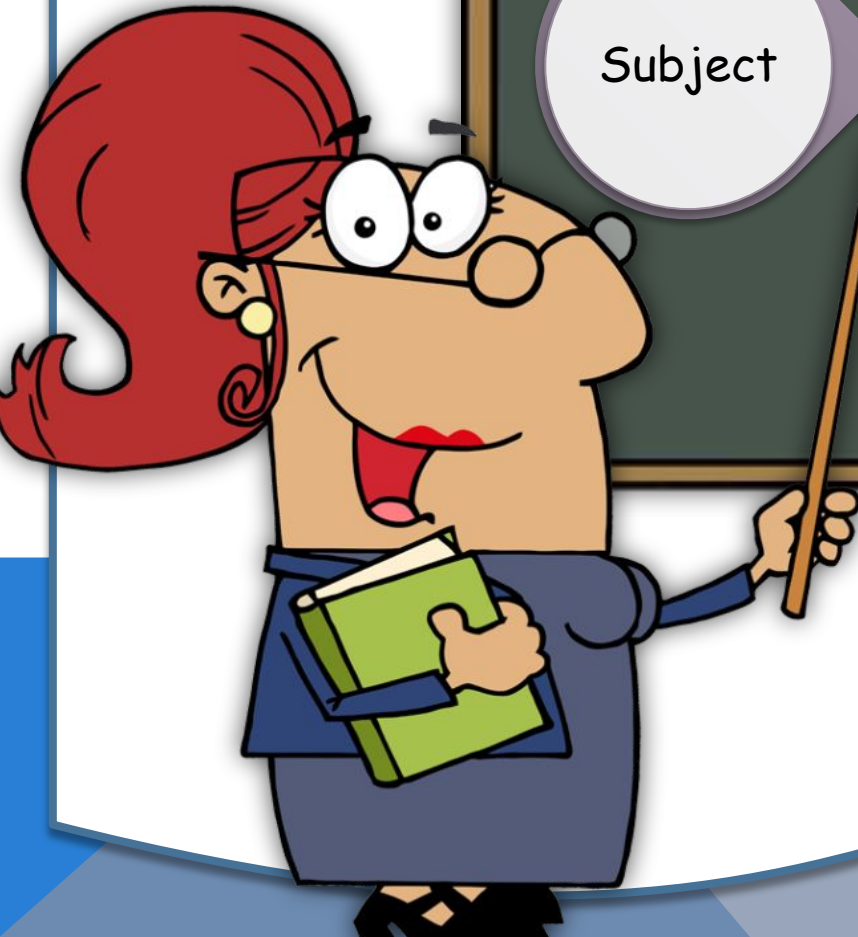
