Overview

- August 9, 2000 – Would recall for than 6.5 million tires.
- 2nd largest biggest in history

Surrounding Events

- 1988 – Firestone weakened by 1978 tire recall.
- March, 1999 – Bridgestone/ Firestone sent a confidential memo to Ford.
- August 1999 – Ford announced a recall in 16 foreign countries.
- Early year 2000
 - Announced “Great Pride in Quality”
 - NHTSA opened a full investigation
 - August
 - September
 - 2001 – President and Chief Executive resigned.
