

IMPERATIVES

The **imperative** is used to give commands, orders and to make suggestions.

EXAMPLES:

- **OPEN** the door, please.
- **LET'S PARK** here.
- **TURN ON** the airconditioned.

We use **DON'T** for the negative form.

- **Don't** BE LATE for classes.
- **Don't** EAT in class.



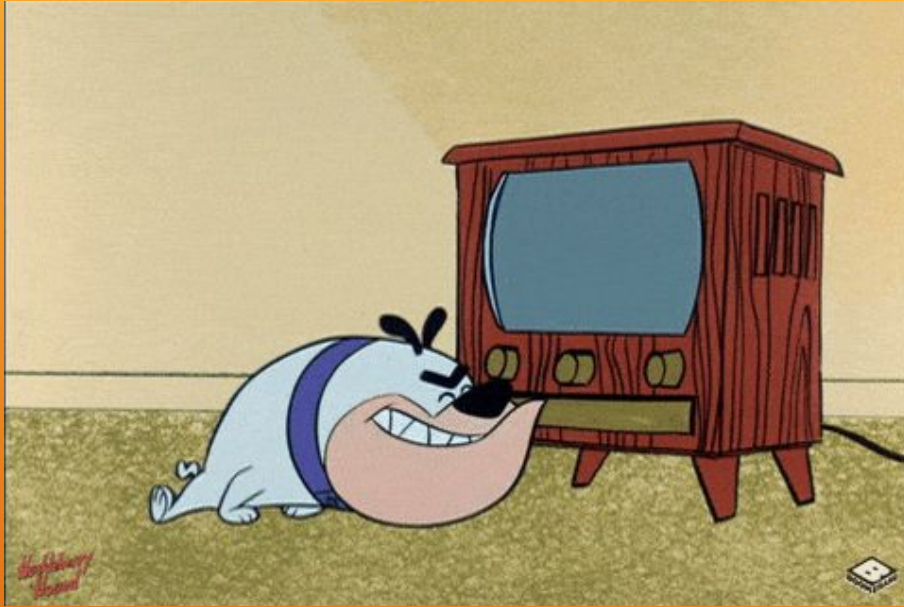


IMPERATIVE

USES OF IMPERATIVES



EXAMPLES:



TURN ON the TV.



PICK UP the trash.



WEAR your
jacket. It's cold
outside.



LET'S GO out the
class is over!

Examples:



DON'T USE YOUR PHONE
IN CLASS.



DON'T LISTEN TO MUSIC
WITHOUT YOUR HEADPHONES
ON THE BUS.
