### IMPERATIVES

The **imperative** is used to give commands, orders and to make suggestions.

#### **EXAMPLES:**

- **OPEN** the door, please.
- LET'S PARK here.
- TURN ON the airconditioned.

We use **DON'T** for the negative form.

- Don't BE LATE for classes.
- Don't EAT in class.










