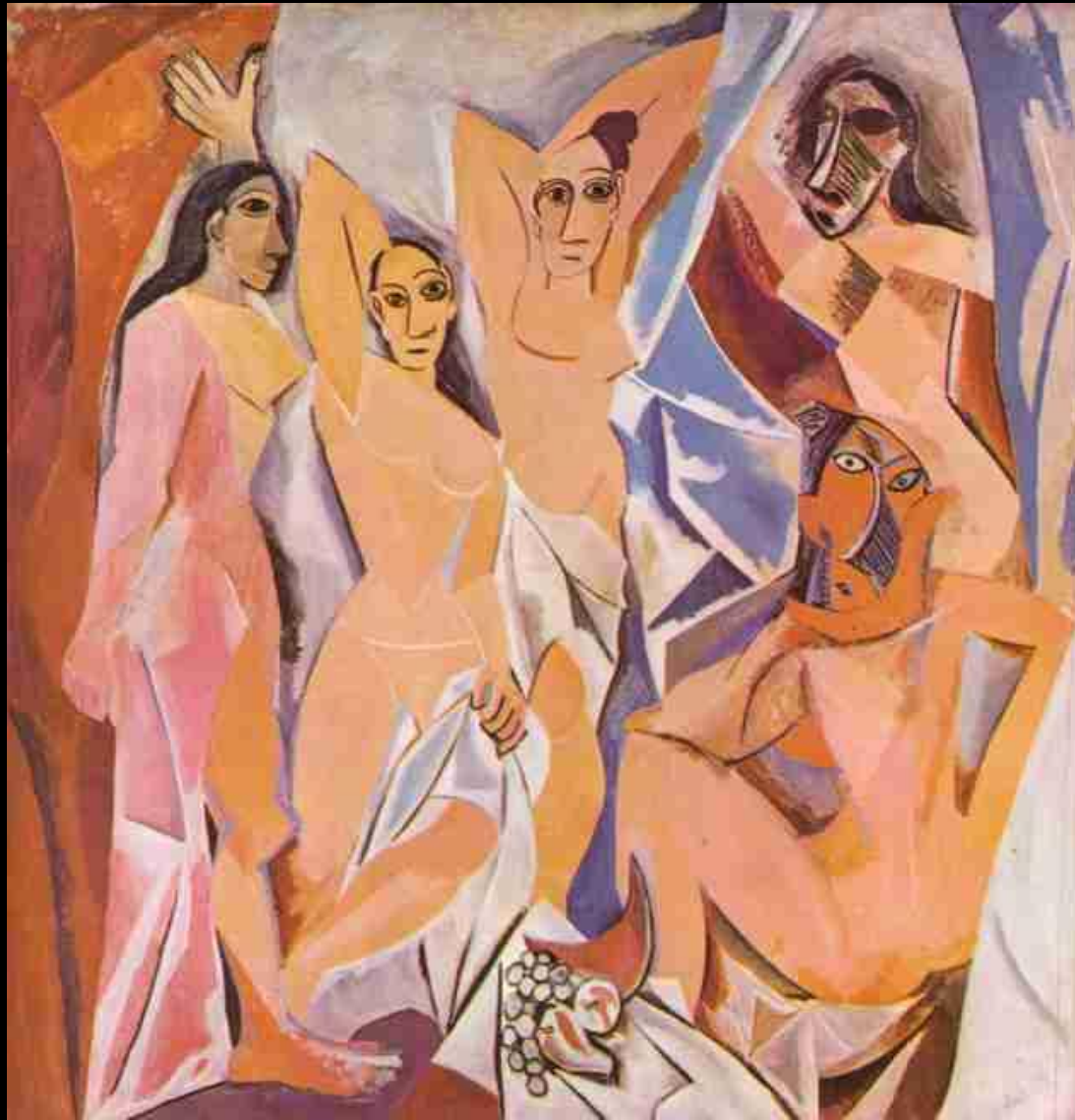




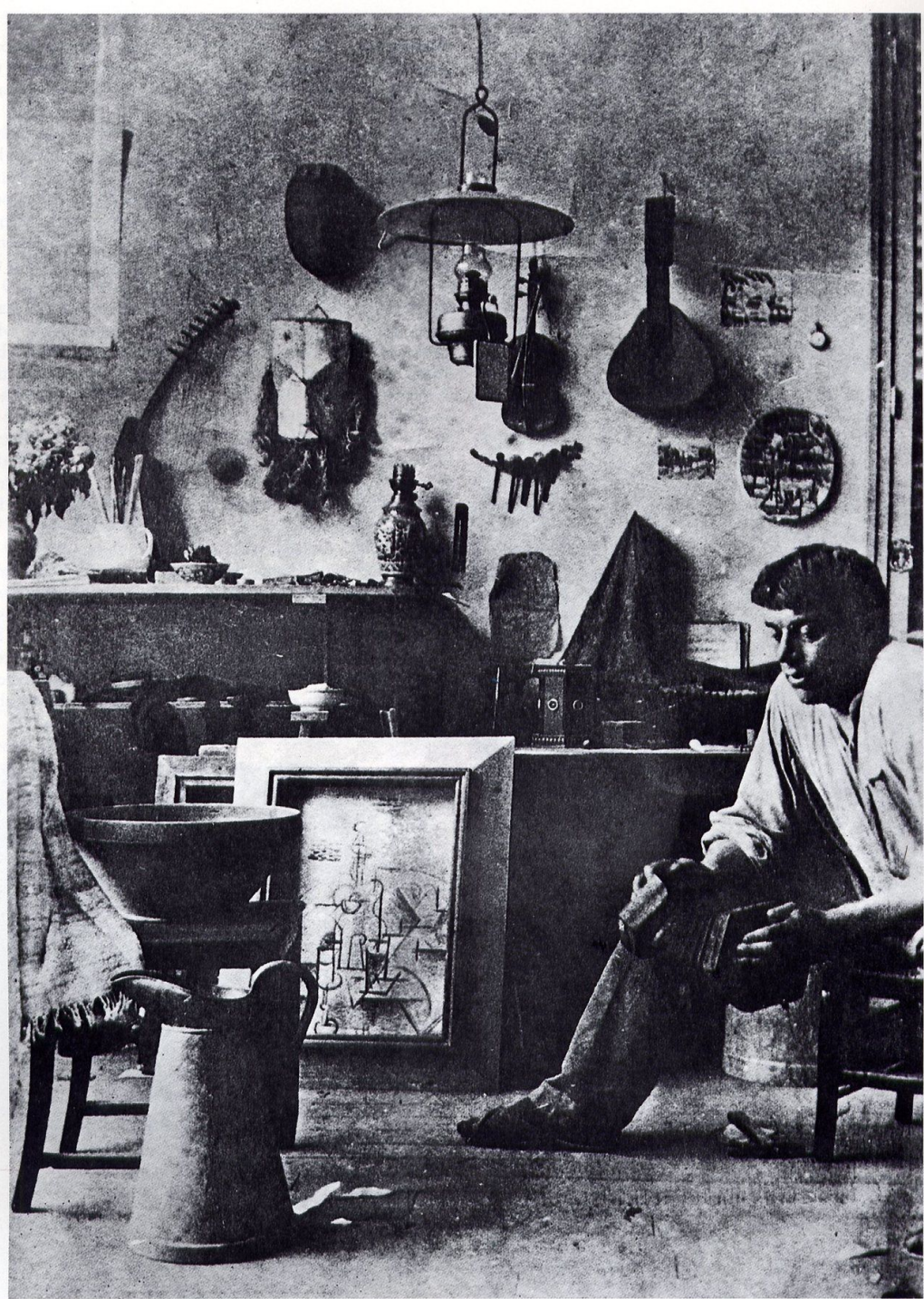

Picasso, *Les Femmes d'Alger (O. K. G.)* (1907)



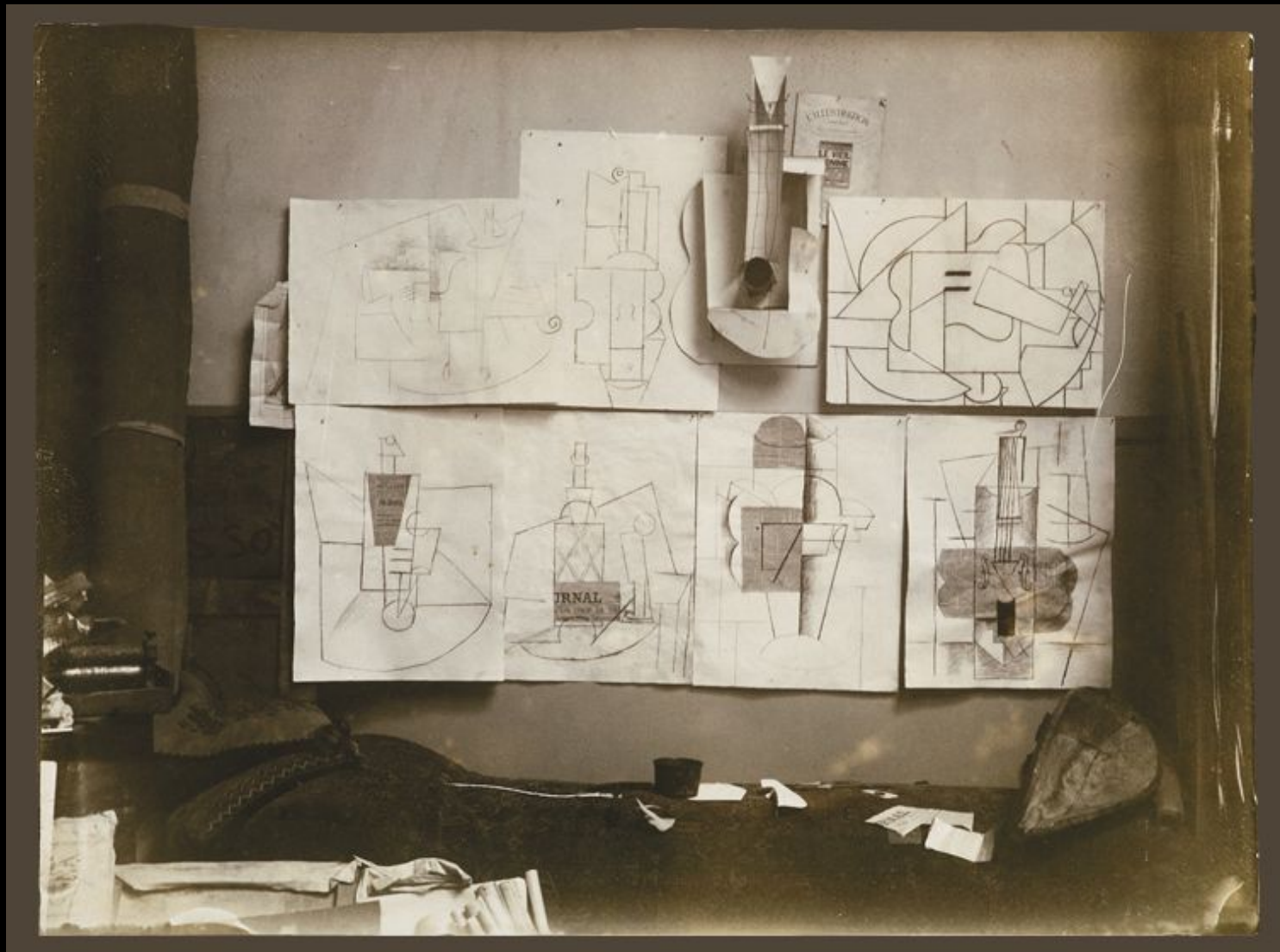

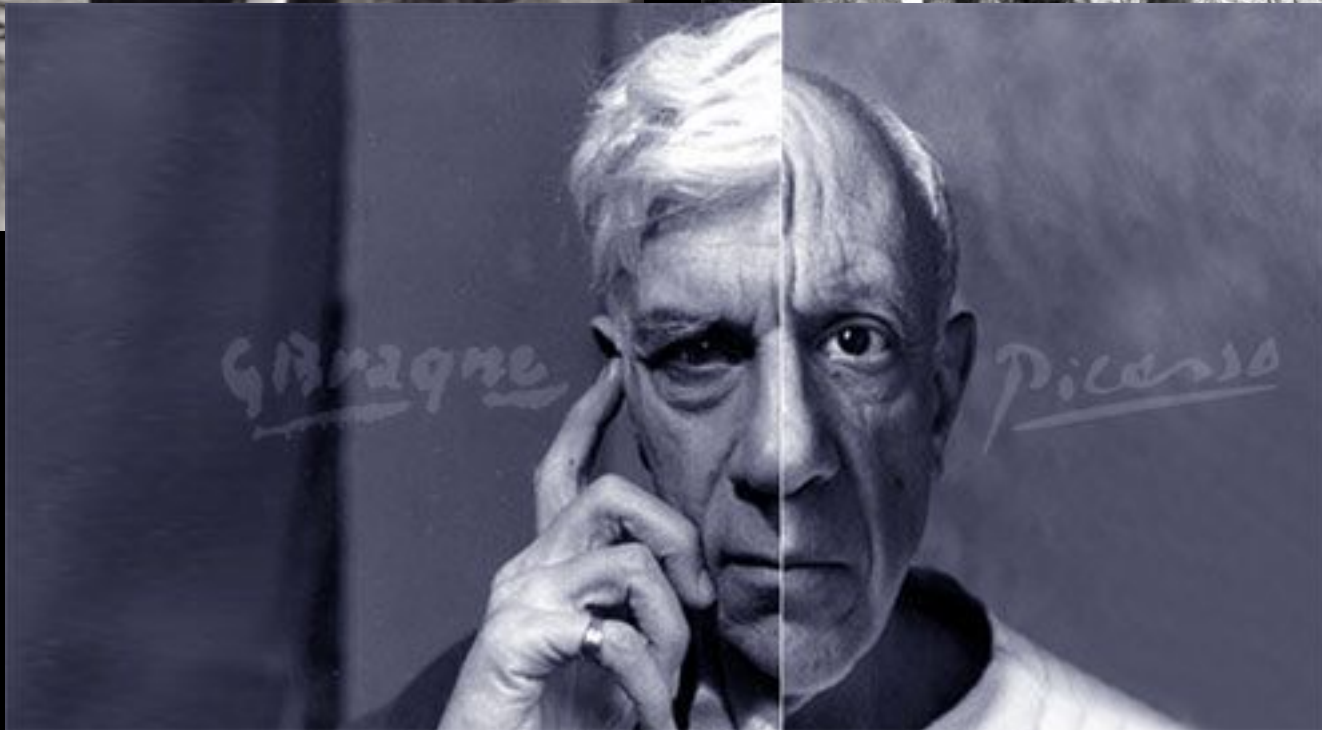
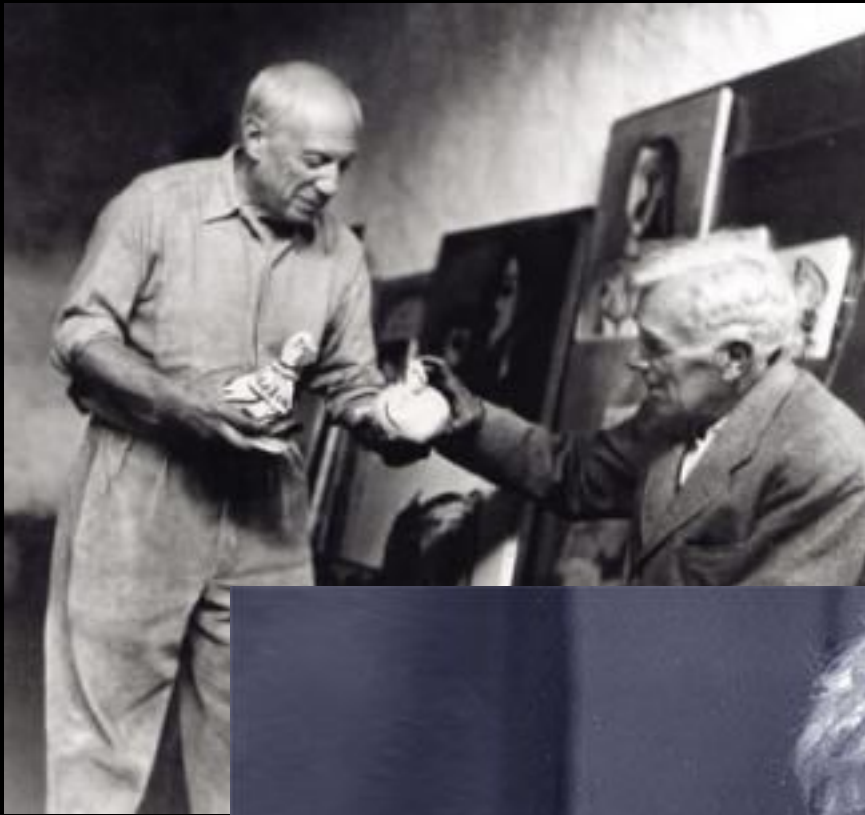
