



# **Telling Time**

# Vocabulary

- hour hand – the thick short hand on the clock
- minute hand – the thick long hand on the clock  
(when it's exactly one o'clock or two o'clock the minute hand is always on the 12)
- o'clock – to tell the exact hour of the day
- colon : - separates the minutes from hours  
(if its one o'clock it can be written 1:00; one hour and zero minutes)




**Watch**


# *Big numbers on a clock*

zero minutes




**6:00**
