Many sports need special shoes.

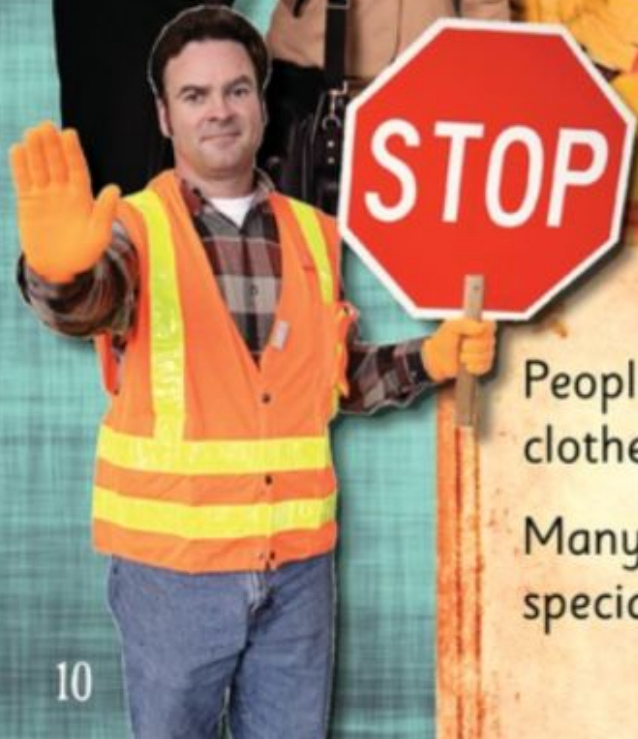
People wear different clothes to play sport.
