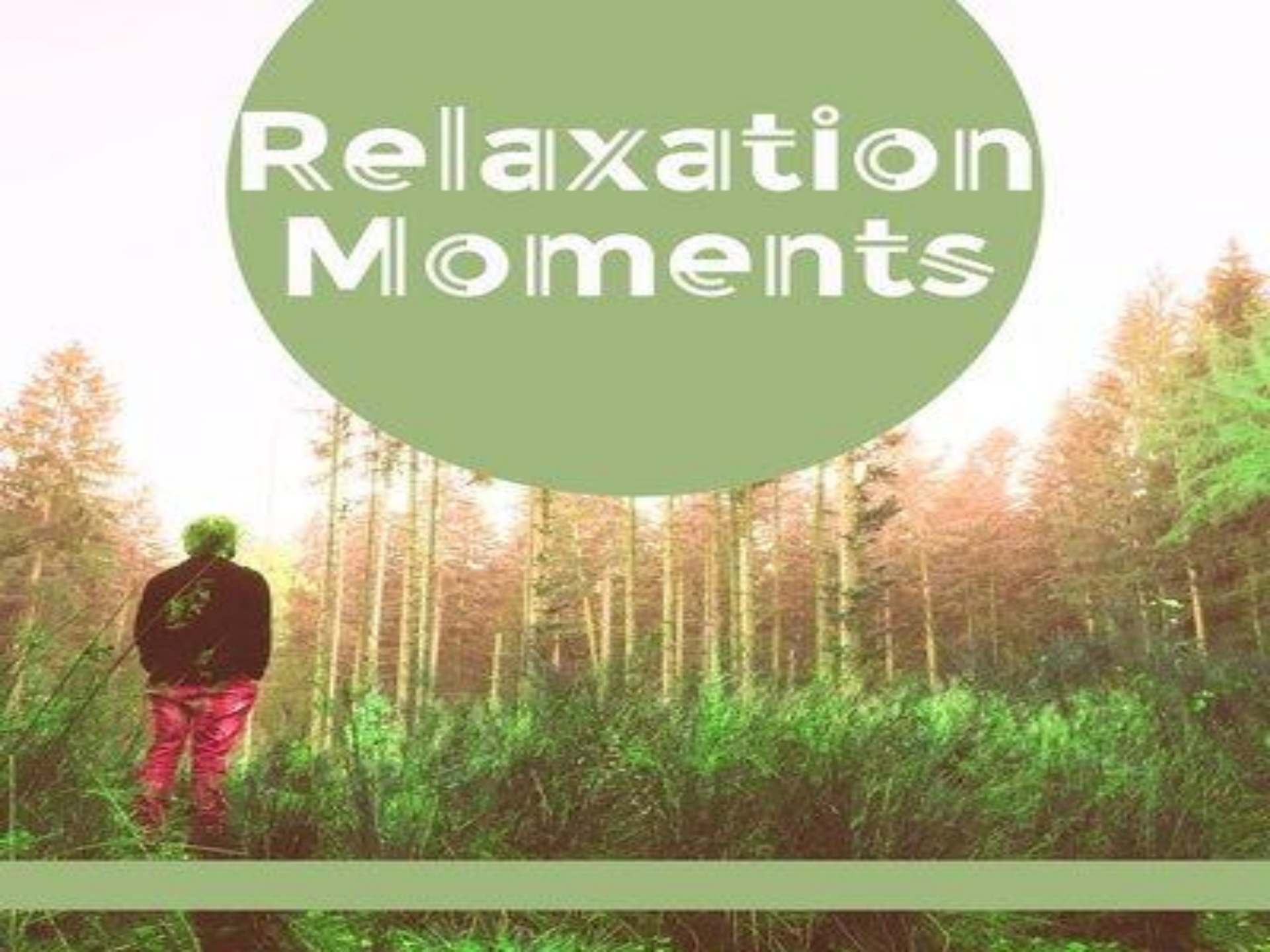


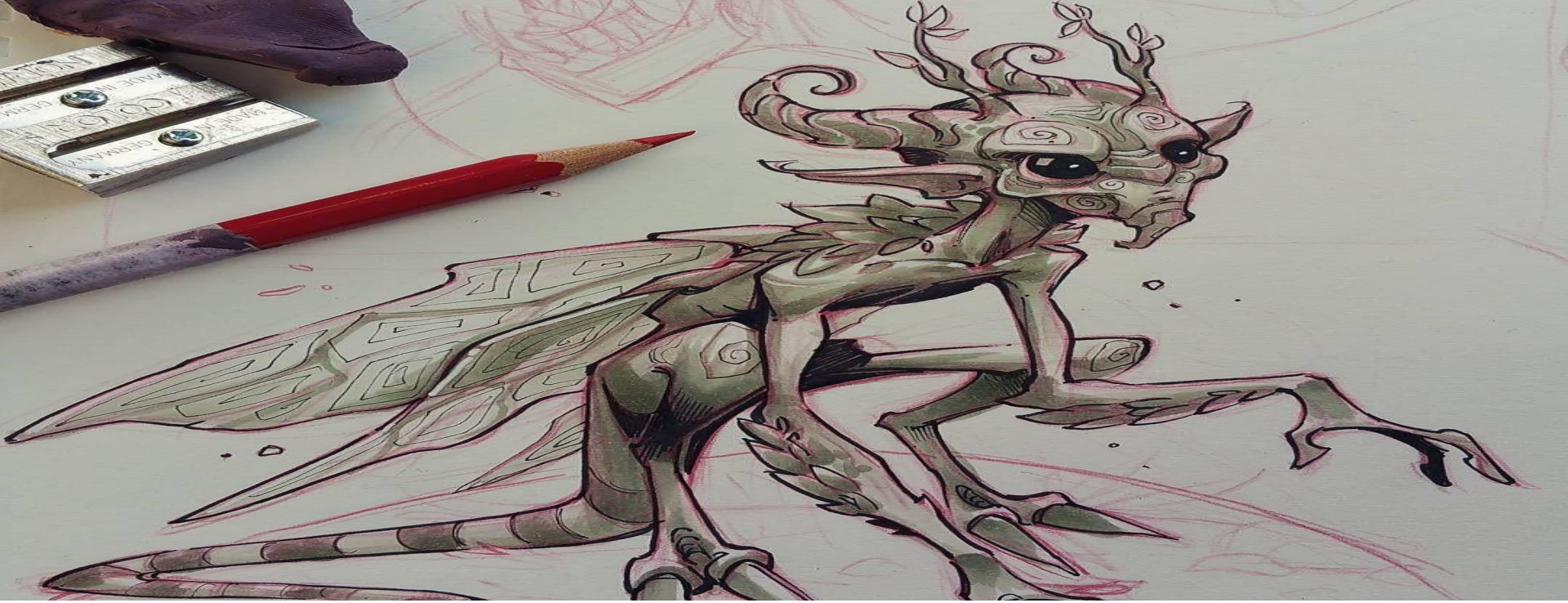






Relaxation Moments
