CUTE

If an adjective has one syllable and ends in "e" just add -r.

The baby koala is cuter than the baby turtle.



BRAVE-----BRAVER

LARGE-----LARGER

RUDE-----RUDER

SAFE-----SAFER

HAPPY

Adjectives that end in **Y** preceded by a consonant just eliminate **Y** and add **-er** at the end.

The baby is **happier** than the woman.



BUSY-----BUSIER

DIRTY-----DIRTIER

COZY-----COZIER

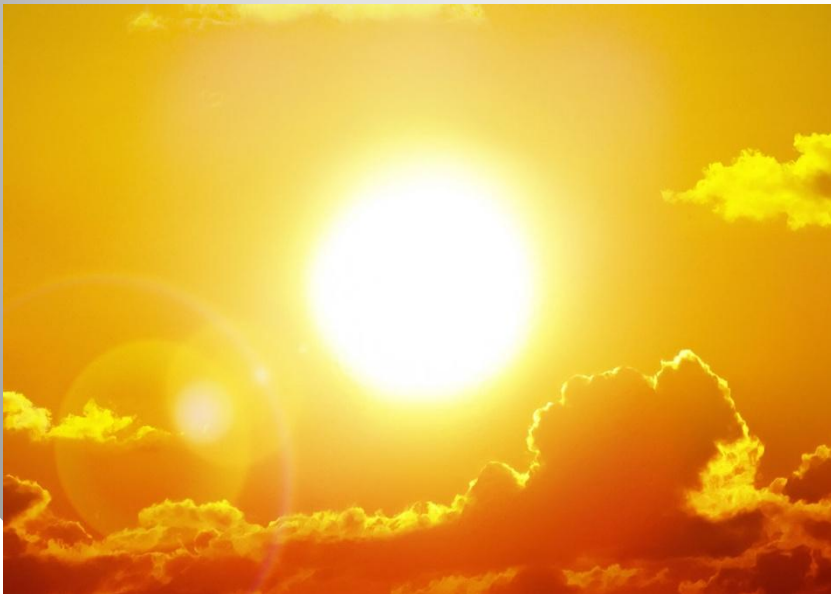
PRETTY-----PRETTIER

LAZY-----LAZIER

HOT

One syllable adjectives that end in consonant.
Double the last consonant and add **-er**.

The sun is hotter than fire.



FAT----- **FAT****T****ER**

BIG----- **BIG****G****ER**

THIN----- **THIN****N****ER**

SAD----- **SAD****D****ER**

BEAUTIFUL

Adjectives with more than two syllables add **more** before the adjective to compare.

A rainbow is **more** beautiful than the rain.



BEAUTIFUL-----MORE BEAUTIFUL

DANGEROUS----MORE DANGEROUS

INTERESTING---MORE INTERESTING

DIFFICULT-----MORE DIFFICULT

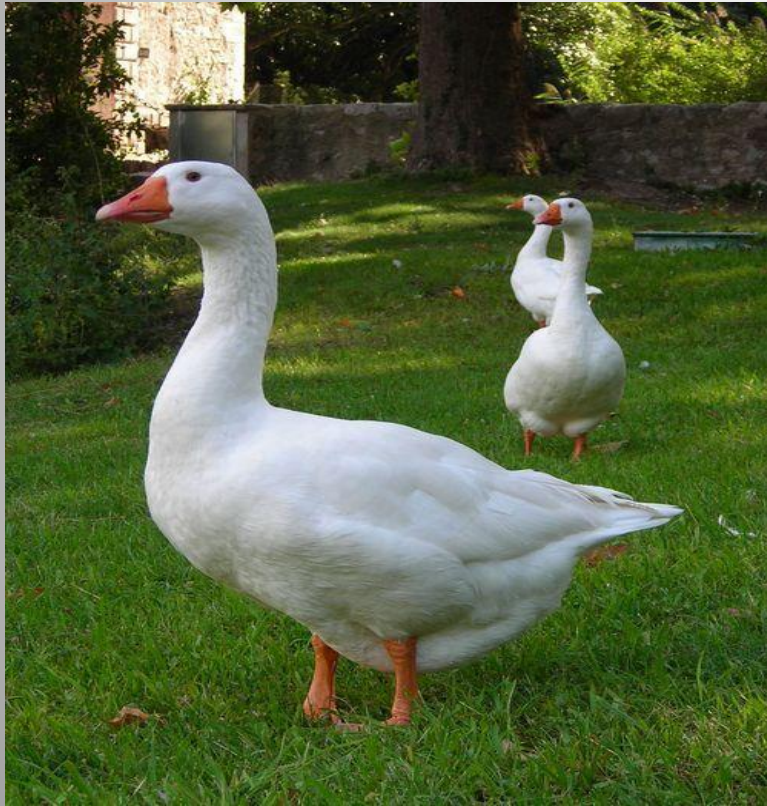

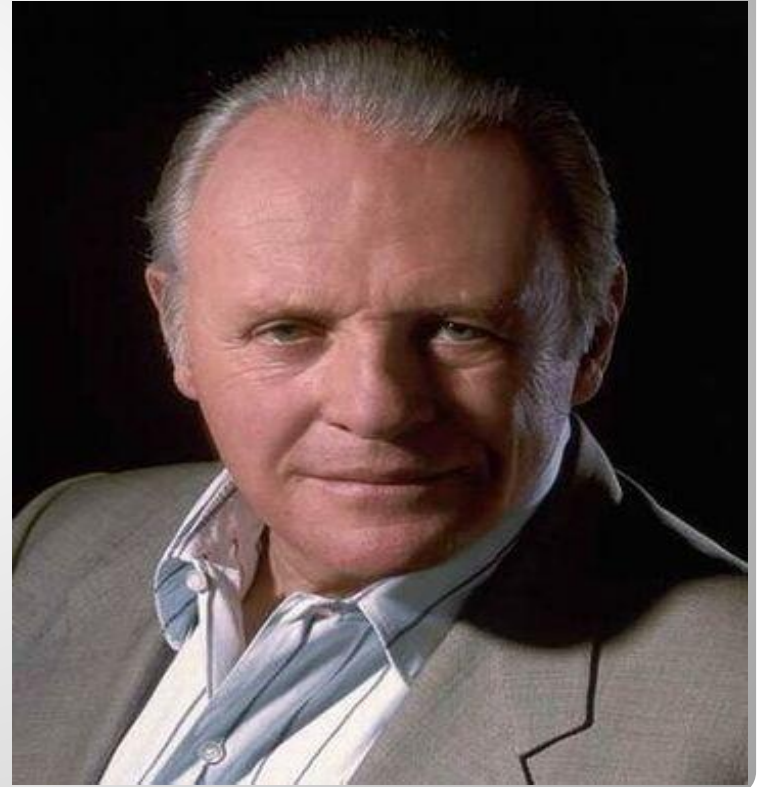
