But yesterday was different. Yesterday was strange.

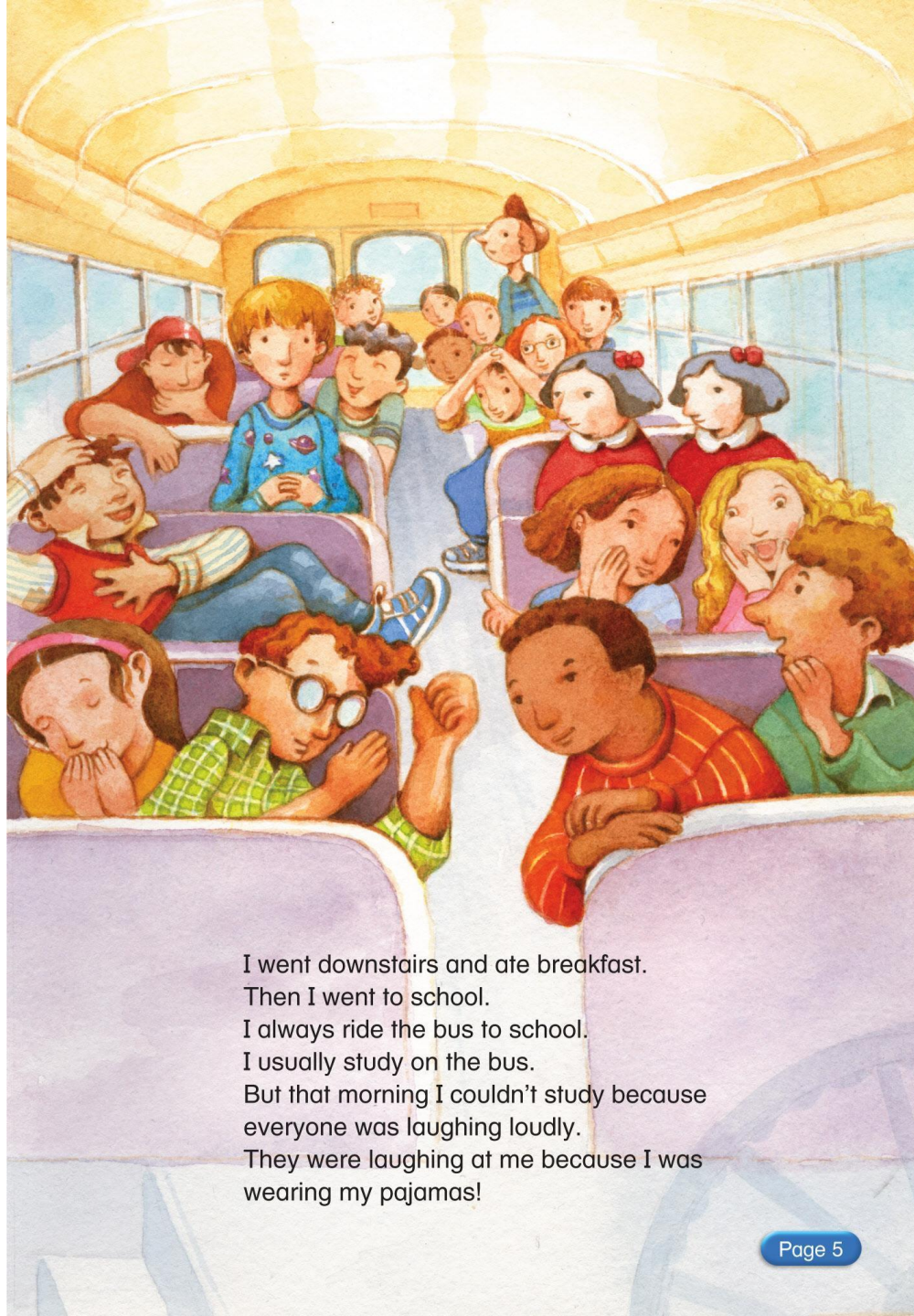




The day began **strangely**.

“Sorry, Mom,” I said, and I turned it down.

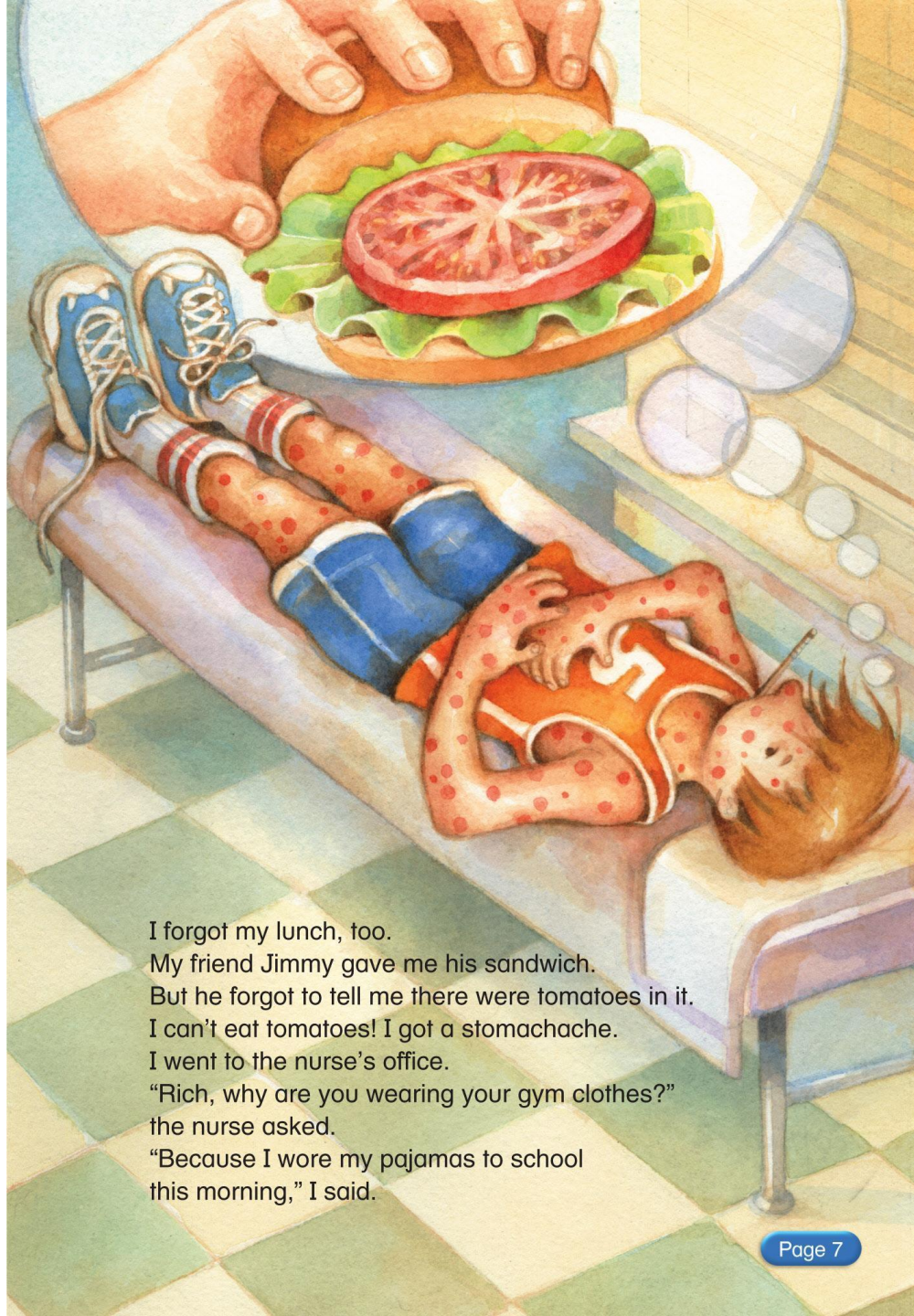





I went downstairs and ate breakfast.

"You were **snoring** loudly," the nurse said.

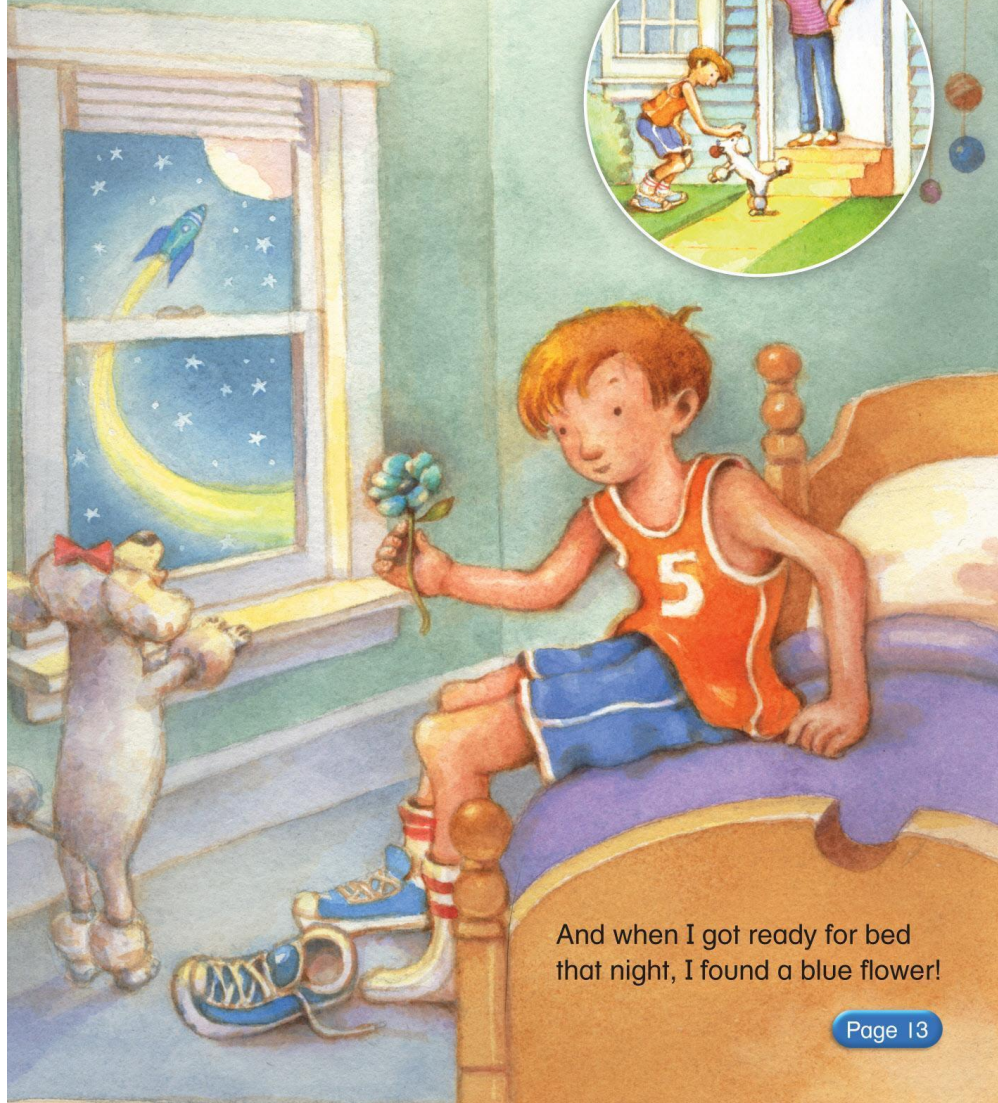
"That's strange. I never snore loudly," I said.

"I went to gym class. I ran. Then I couldn't open the door, and I met a girl with blue hair," I said.

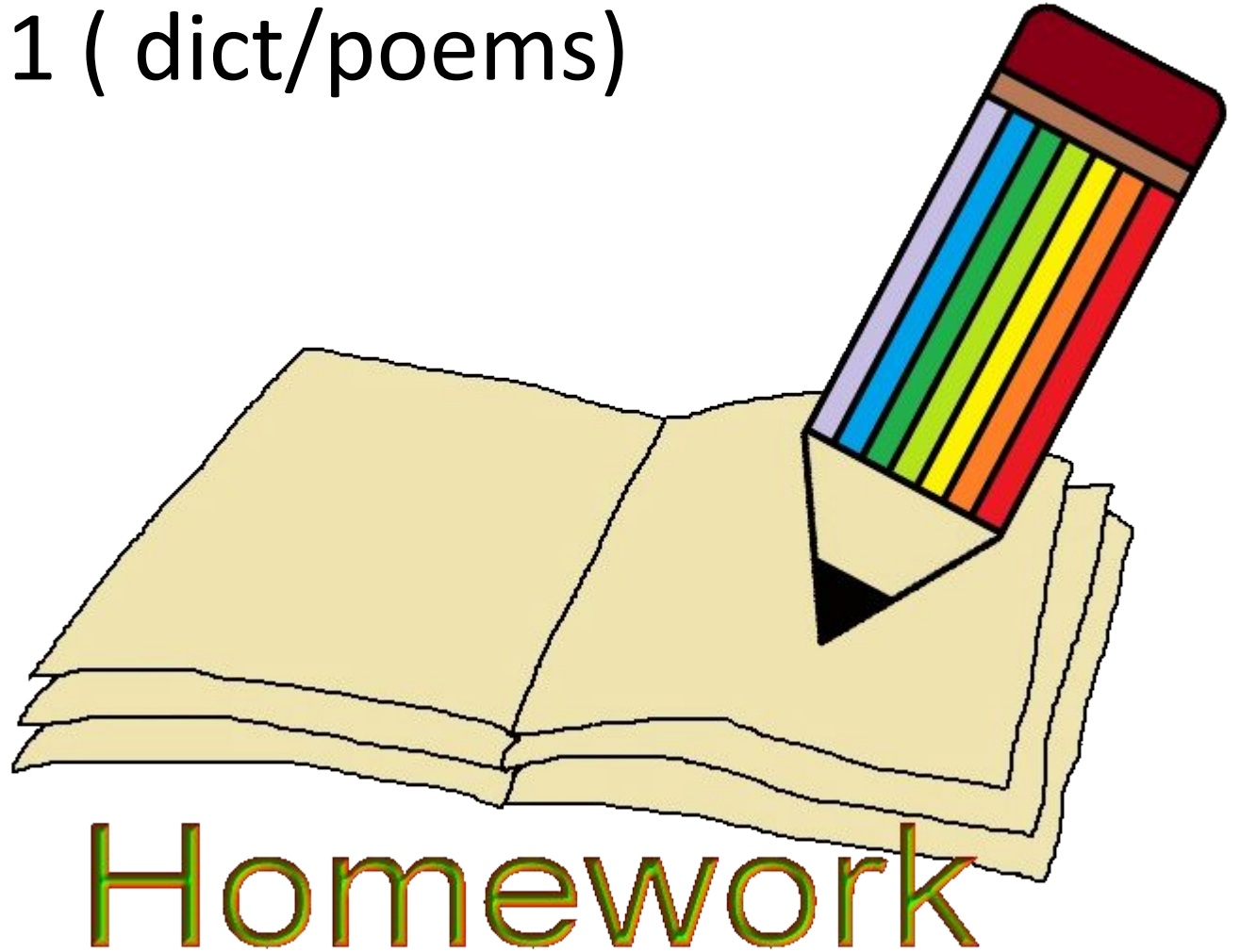
"You had a dream," the nurse said. "You should hurry, or you'll miss your bus."
