

Simple Present Tense

We use the simple present tense when we are writing about something that is **repeated**, is **always true** or is **happening in a future time**.

Repeated

Eva wakes up at half past seven every morning.

I walk to school.

I ride my bike every weekend.

Always or generally true

The sun sets in the west.

I speak Urdu.

They live in a city.

Happening in a future time

The bus leaves at 9 o'clock.

The film starts at half past three.

The form of the verb depends on the subject.

I you we they

run sing laugh jump

he she

(third person singular)

runs
sings
laughs
jumps

-o, -ch, -sh, -ss, -s, -x or -z

Example

s: fix - fixes

go-goes **-es** wish - wishes





buzz - buzzes





The spelling of the verb depends on the ending of the verb. Verbs ending in:

Consonant and -y

Remove -y and add


Example

S:

carry - carries

-ies

cry - cries









The spelling of the verb depends on the ending of the verb. Verbs ending in:

Vowel and -y



Example

S:

say – says




play - plays




buy - buys
