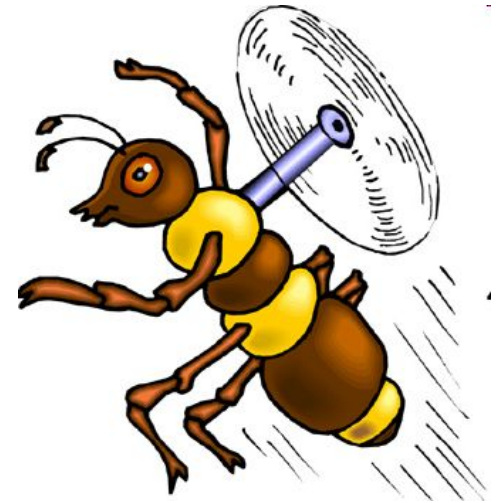
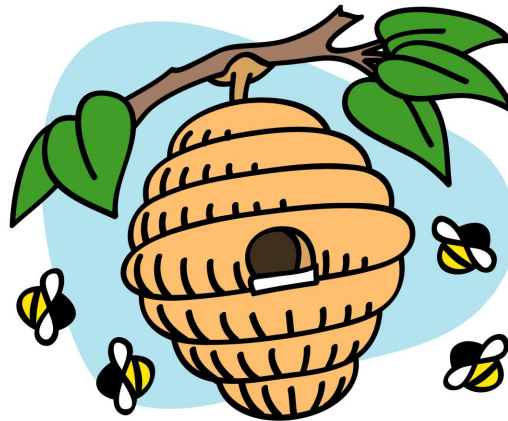


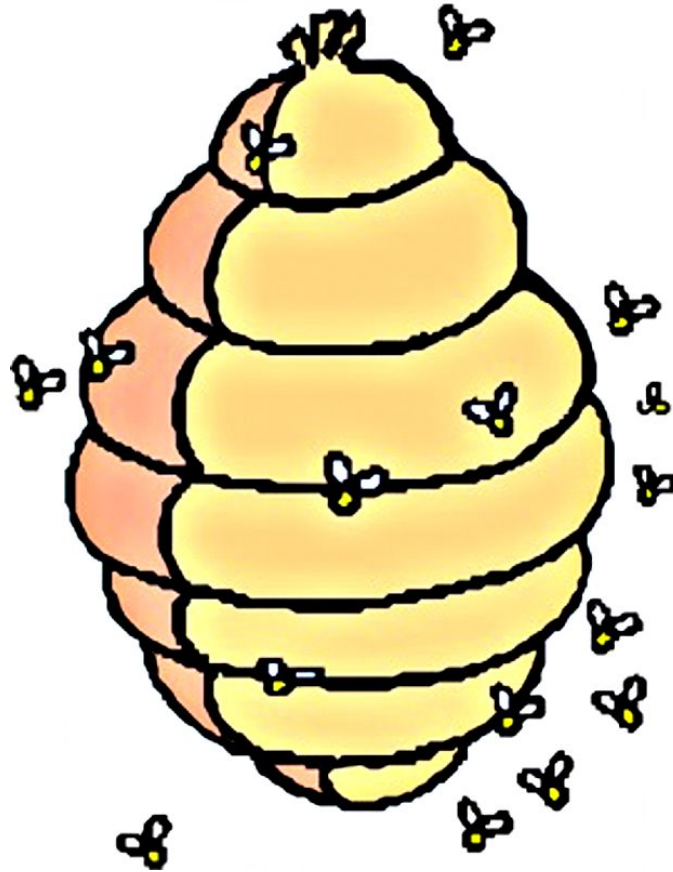


BEEES

work together to build a hive.

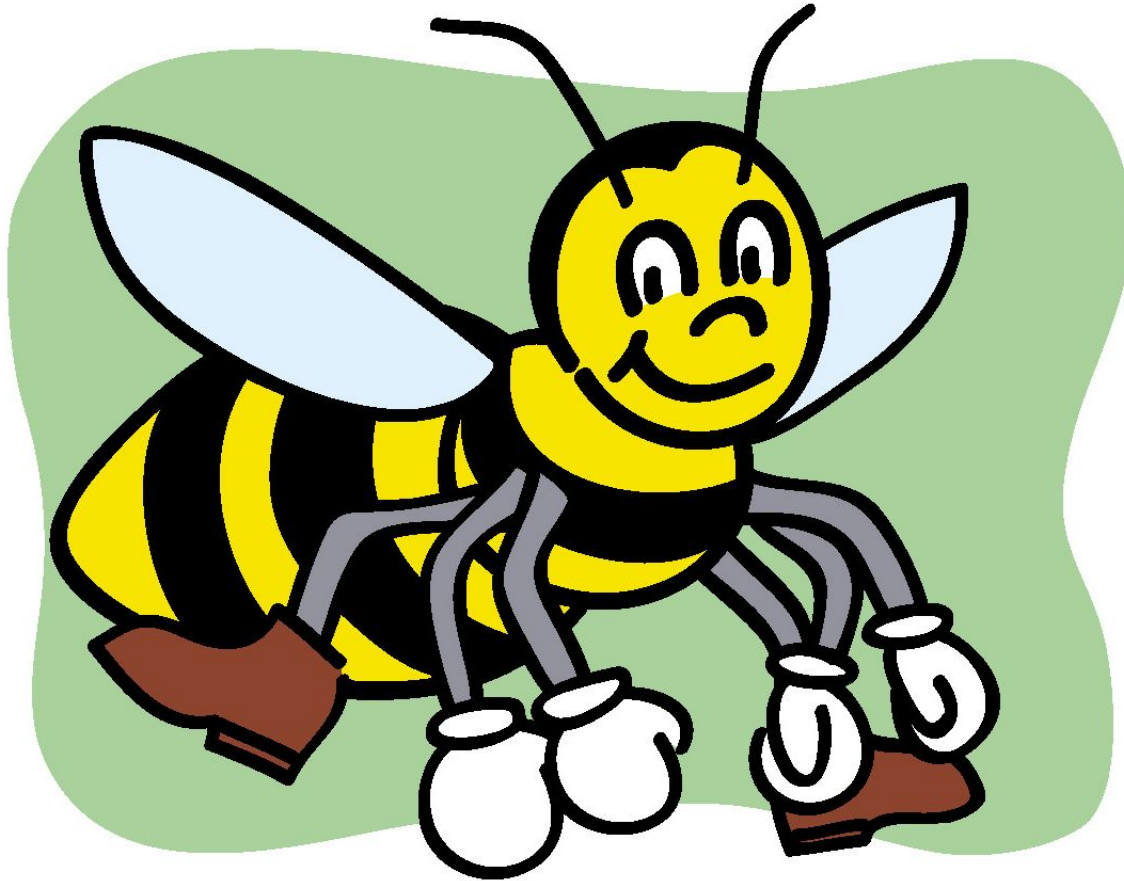
Bees are built for collecting honey.

Forager bees collect pollen and nectar from flowers and bring it to the hive.



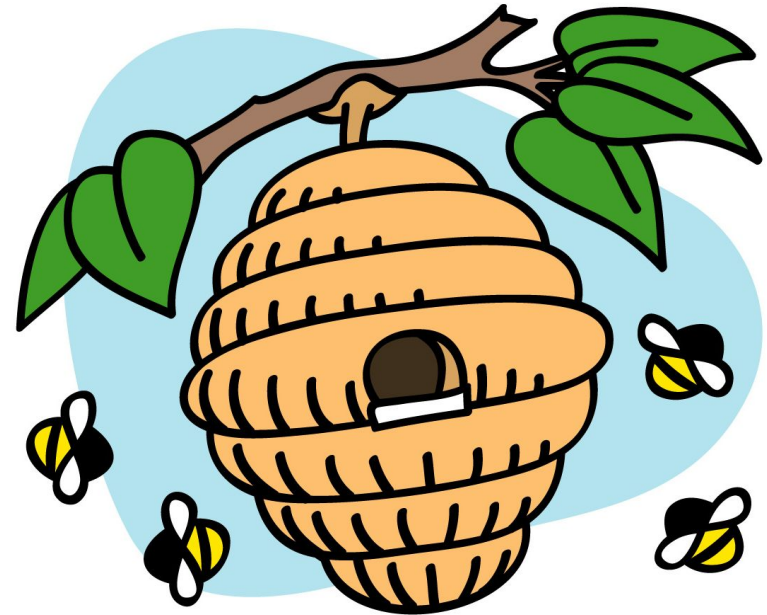
House bees turn the pollen and
nectar into honey.

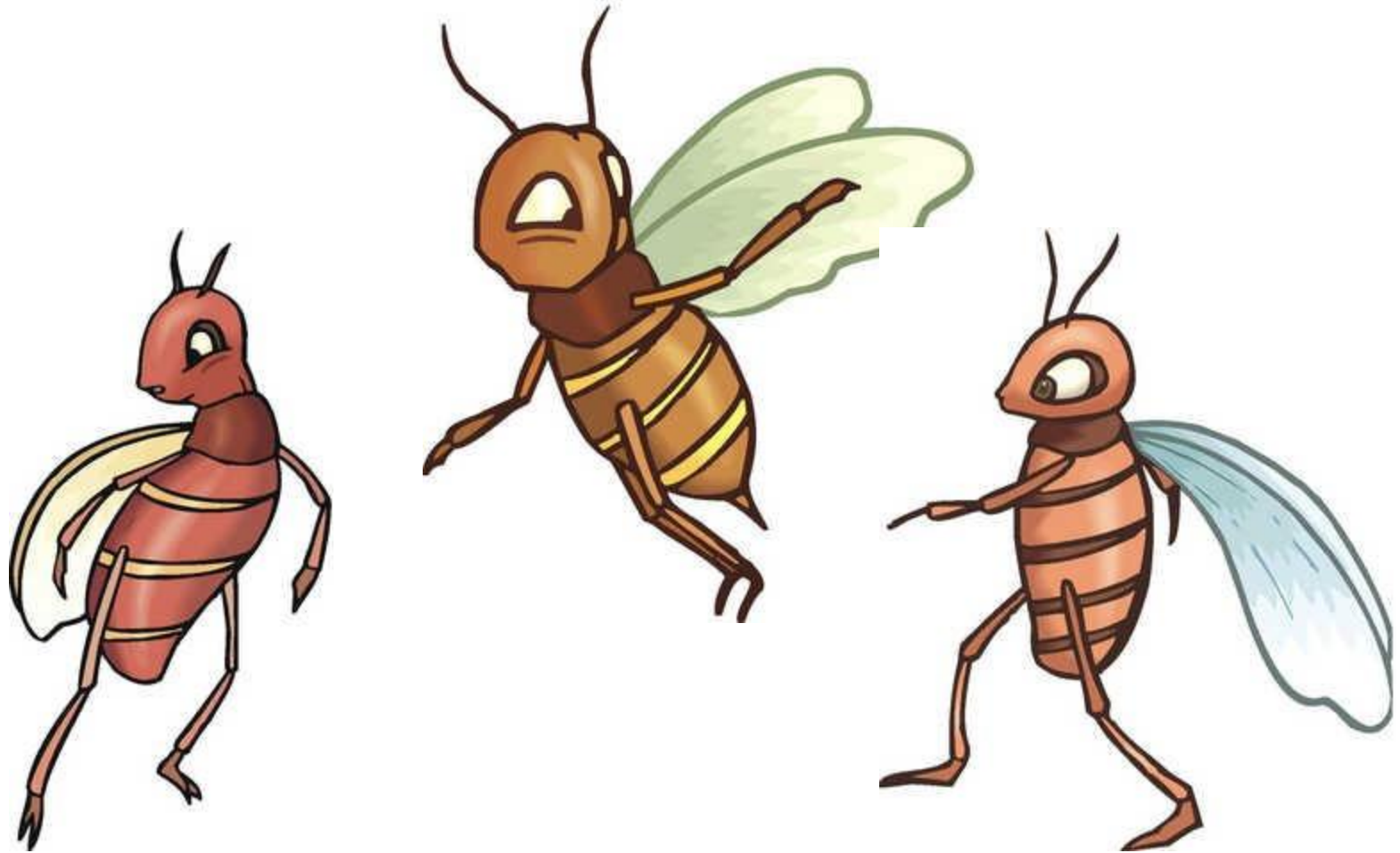


Worker bees also build the honeycomb structure.

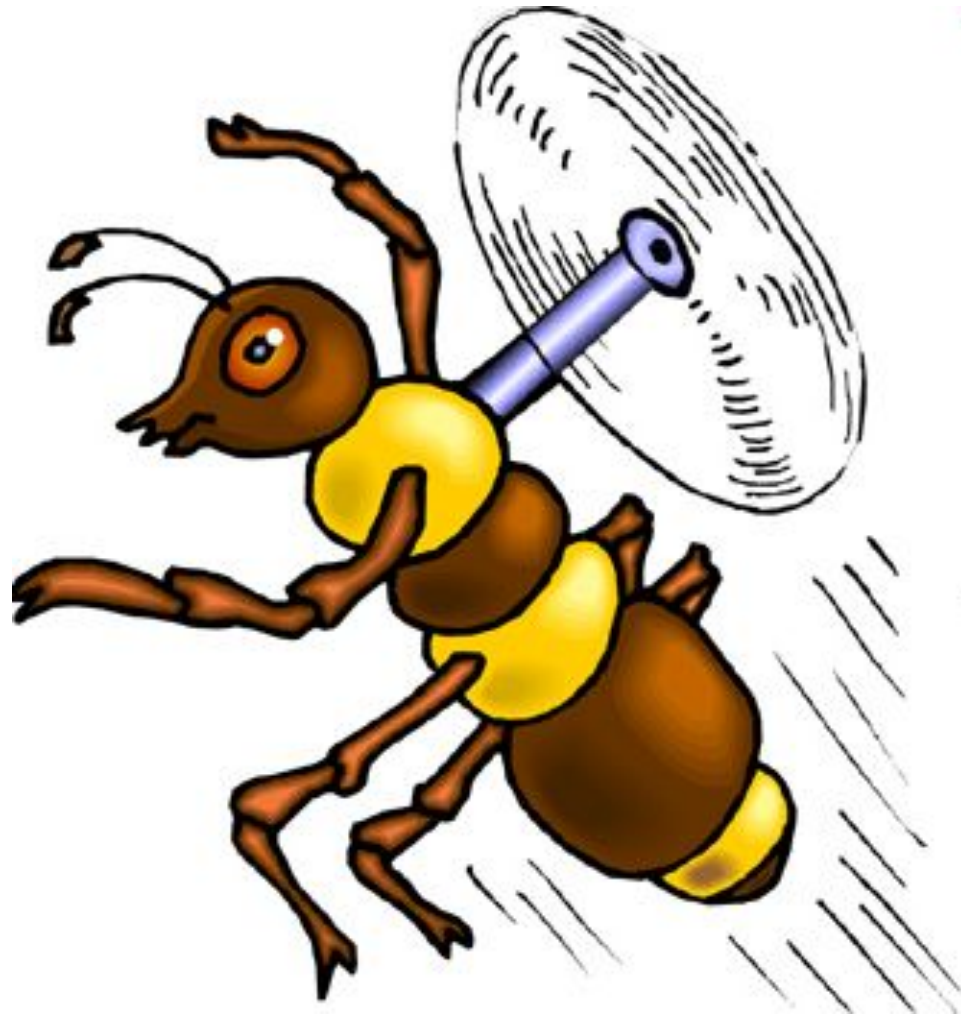
Worker Bees Work Hard!
