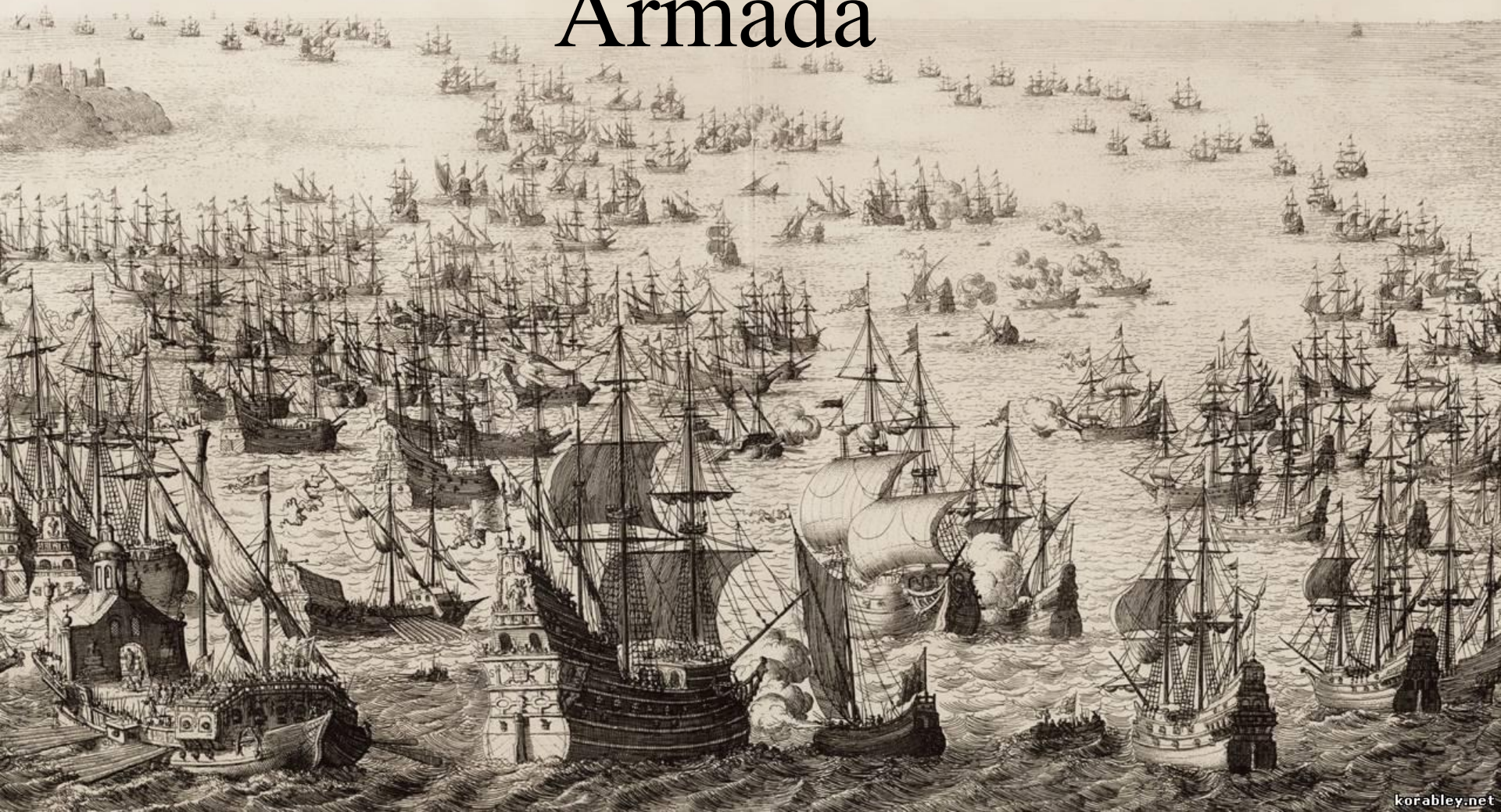

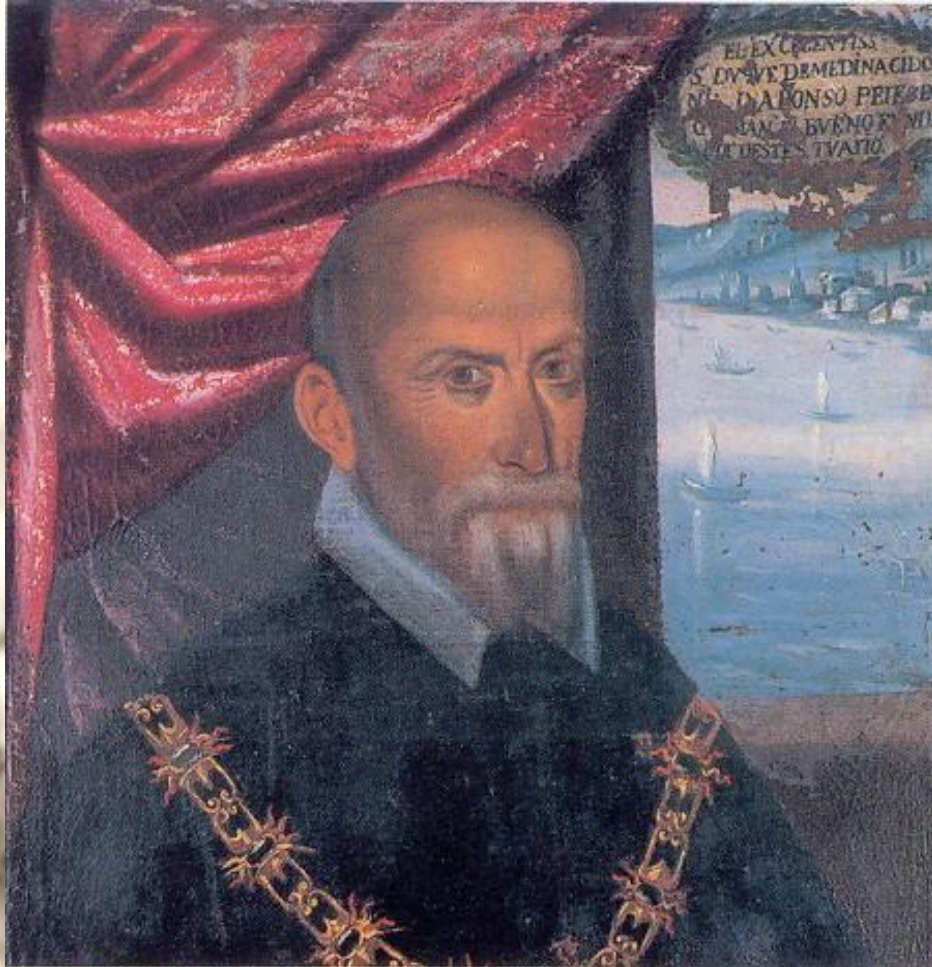


Elizabeth I Tudor
