




### What is a family?

At present the British royal family is headed by Queen Elizabeth.



When the Queen was born on the 21 of April 1926, her grandfather, King George V, was on the throne. She came to the throne after her father's death in 1952 and was crowned in Westminster Abbey in June 1953.

The marriage of the young Princess Elizabeth to Philip, Duke of Edinburgh took place in November 1947.

Wales, who was born in 1948





In 1981 Prince Charles married Lady Diana Spencer.

Lady Diana became very popular in Britain and was called "the Queen of Hearts"

On the 29<sup>th</sup> of April, 2011 Prince William got married to Katherine Middleton, Duchess of Cambridge









The Queen's other children are **Prince Andrew** (born in 1960) and **Prince Edward**(born in 1964) and **Princess Anne**, who was born in 1950, is the only daughter of Queen Elisabeth II.
