Adverbs of manner

Adverbs of manner describe verbs.

He is eating his lunch quickly. (How is he eating his lunch? Quickly.)

We form adverbs of manner by adding -ly to the adjective.

loud - loudly easy - easily careful - carefully BUT

Some adjectives do not form their adverbs in the same way. These are: good - well fast - fast hard - hard




