ADVERBS

Adverbs of manner

Adverbs of manner describe verbs.

He is eating his lunch **quickly**. (How is he eating his lunch? Quickly.)

We form adverbs of manner by adding *-ly* to the adjective.

careful – carefully

loud – loudly

BUT

easy – easily

Some adjectives do not form their adverbs in the same way. These are:

good – well

fast – fast

hard – hard

exception	example
silent e is dropped in <i>true, due, whole</i>	<i>true</i> → <i>truly</i>
<i>y</i> becomes <i>i</i>	<i>happy</i> → <i>happily</i>
<i>le</i> after a consonant is dropped	<i>sensible</i> → <i>sensibly</i>
after <i>ll</i> only add <i>y</i>	<i>full</i> → <i>fully</i>

Adjectives ending in *-ic*: adjective + *-ally* (exception: public-publicly)

adjective	adverb
fantastic	fantastically
