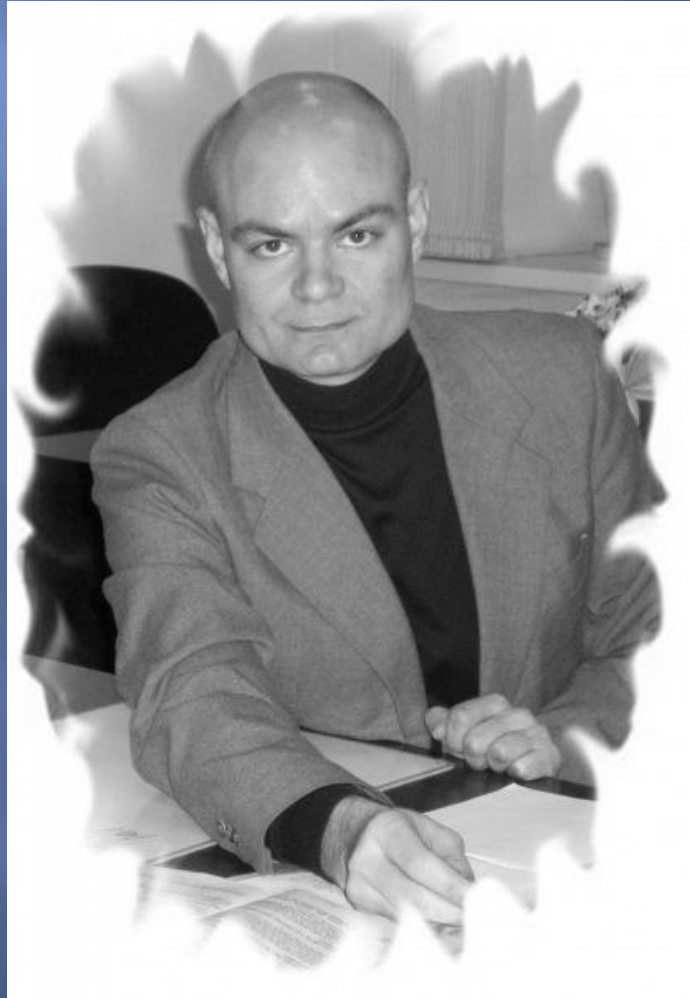

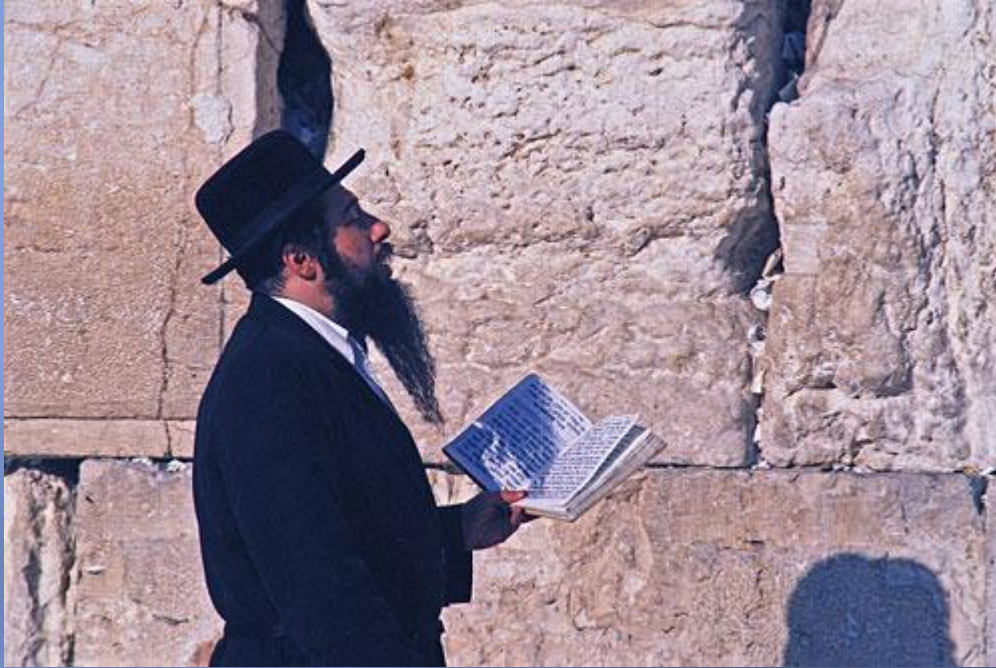
Some myths and facts about Jews

It's a *legend*.

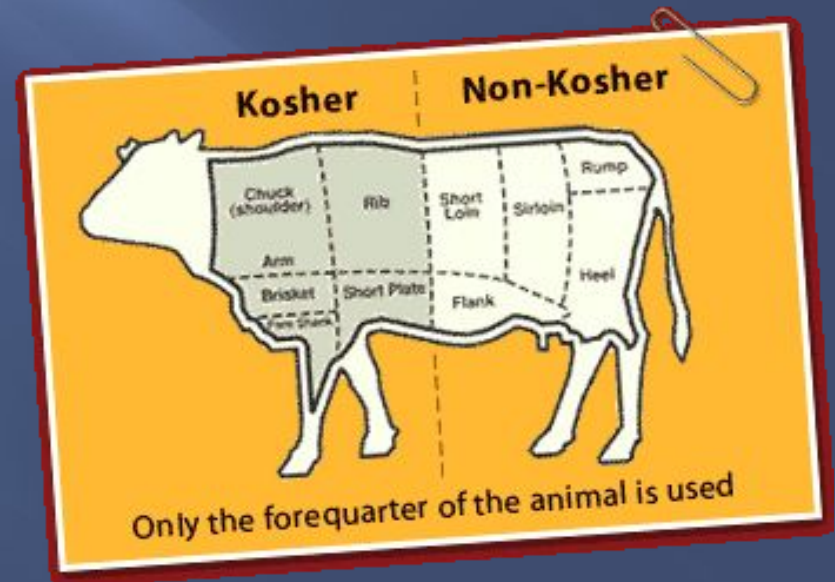




Things you probably didn't know about Jews

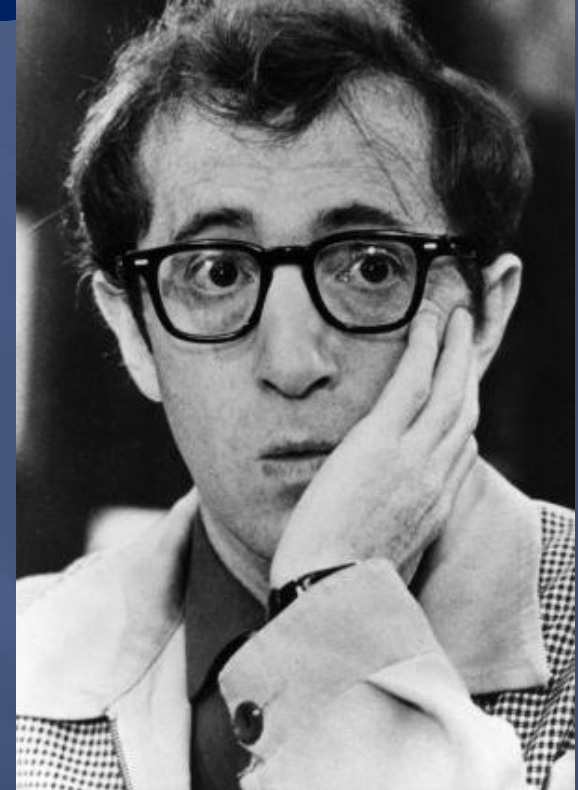
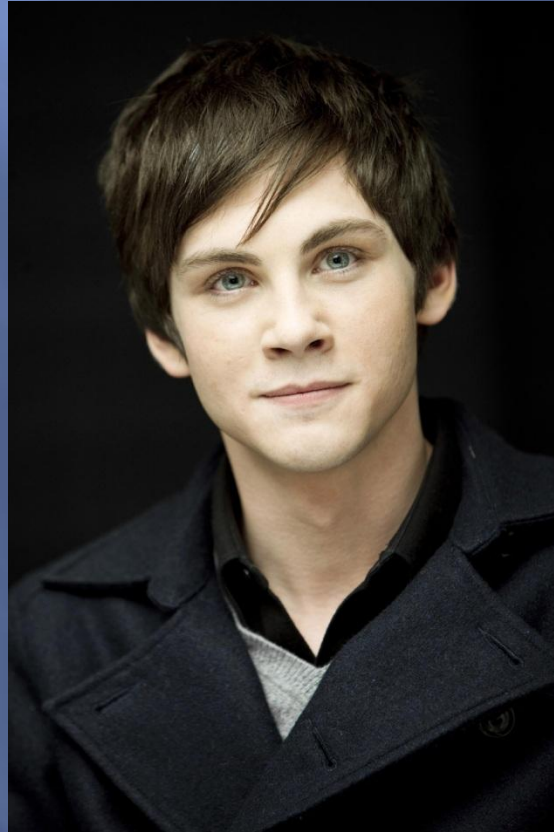


Things you probably didn't know about Jews
