#### Exploring Language Pedagogy through Second Language Acquisition Research



Those linguistic forms in the input that are **noticed** (i.e. consciously attended to) are more likely to be acquired than those that are not noticed.

Acquisition is also enhanced when **learners notice-the-gap** (i.e. pay attention to **the difference** between the **input** and their **own output**).
