In the USA, in the state of Nebraska, there is the city of Valentine. The city is named for Edward Kimble Valentine, a Nebraska Republican politician.



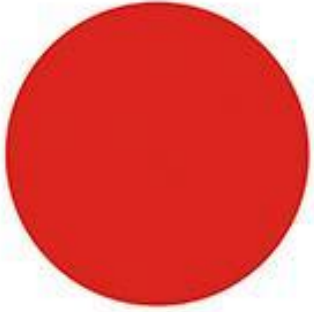


Germany



In 1496, the Catholic Church recognized the priest's merits, ranked him as a Saint, and declared February 14 Valentine's Day.







Japan
