In the USA, in the state of Nebraska, there is the city of Valentine. The city is named for Edward Kimble Valentine, a Nebraska Republican politician.



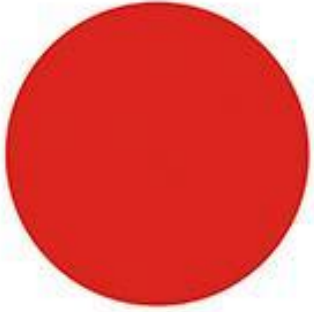


# Germany
