# UNIVERSITY

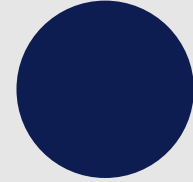
- University provides a powerful foundation of theoretical knowledge
- Faculty of Journalism at the university has a much more extensive training program, which includes a deep study of literature, history, management and marketing courses in journalism.



# IMPROVE JOURNALISM COURSES



in journalism courses they mainly teach only certain leads, how to: correctly speak, how to behave, what is and where?



to improve efficiency, they must add theoretical knowledge to the training based on practice, this is analysis, structure, and philological knowledge.

# IMPROVE JOURNALISM FACULTIES

## THEORY AND PRACTICE 50-50



At the Faculty of Journalism there is a lot of theory, but the practice is only in the 4th year if theory is reinforced by practice every time, learning will be effective.

For the Faculty of Journalism, 4 years of study is a very long time.

The training base should have: International politics, sociology, television journalism, newspaper journalism, radio journalism, new media, online journalism, literature, psychology, and physiology. All of these subjects can be studied in 2 years. Students of the faculty of journalism lose practice time on unnecessary subjects. 2 years can be devoted to practice.
