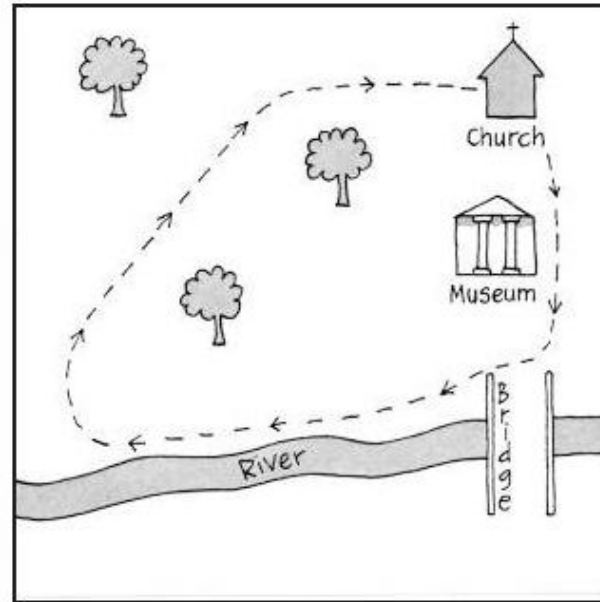
30. Which map represents the Fun Run?

Fun Run

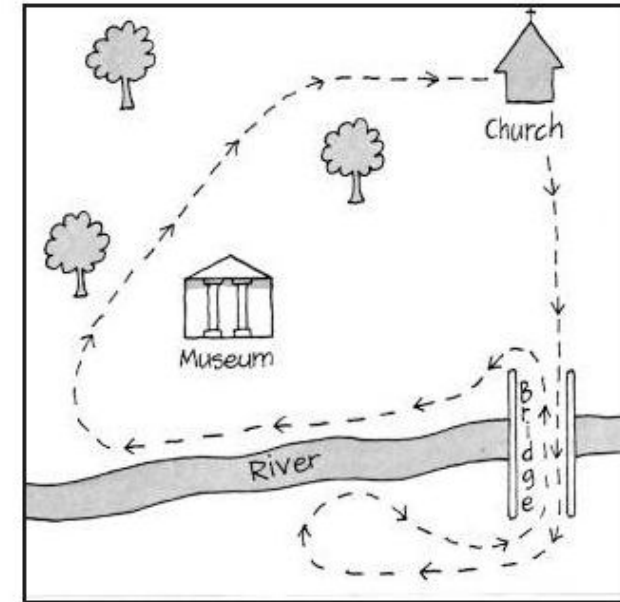
