

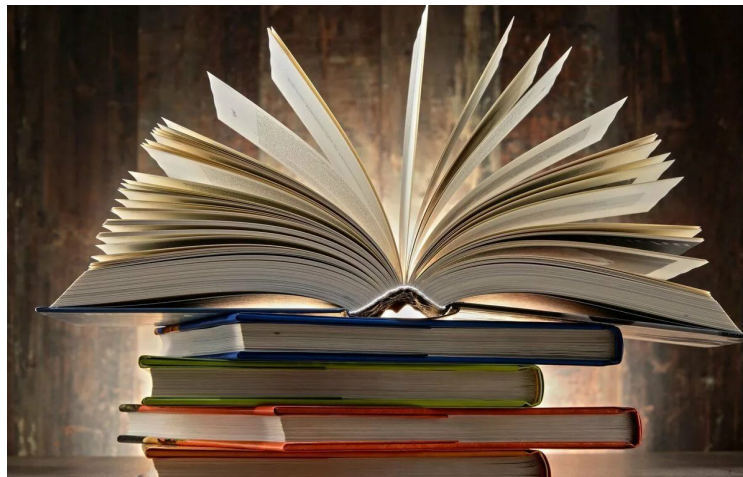
Understanding culture through literary texts
