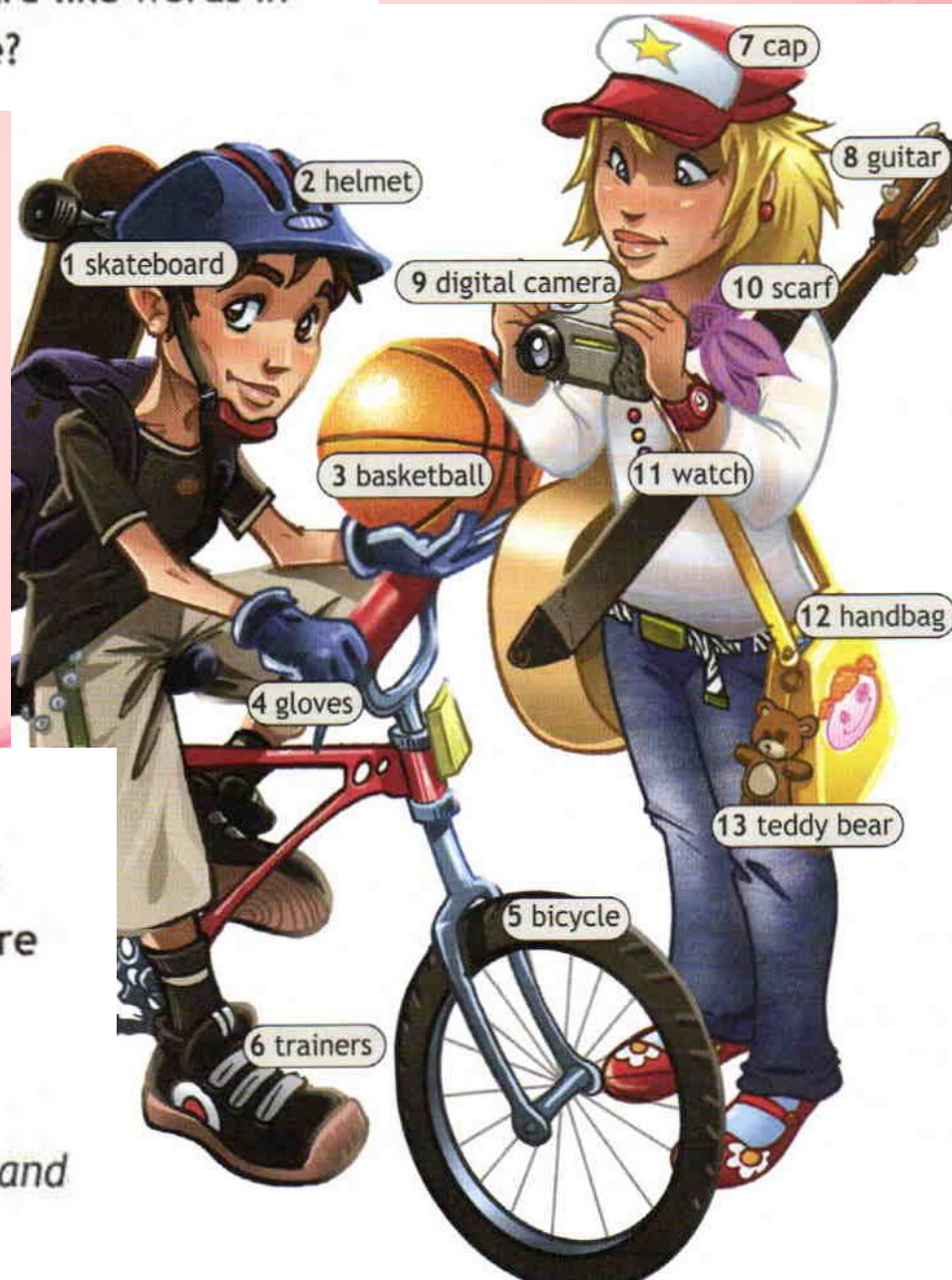

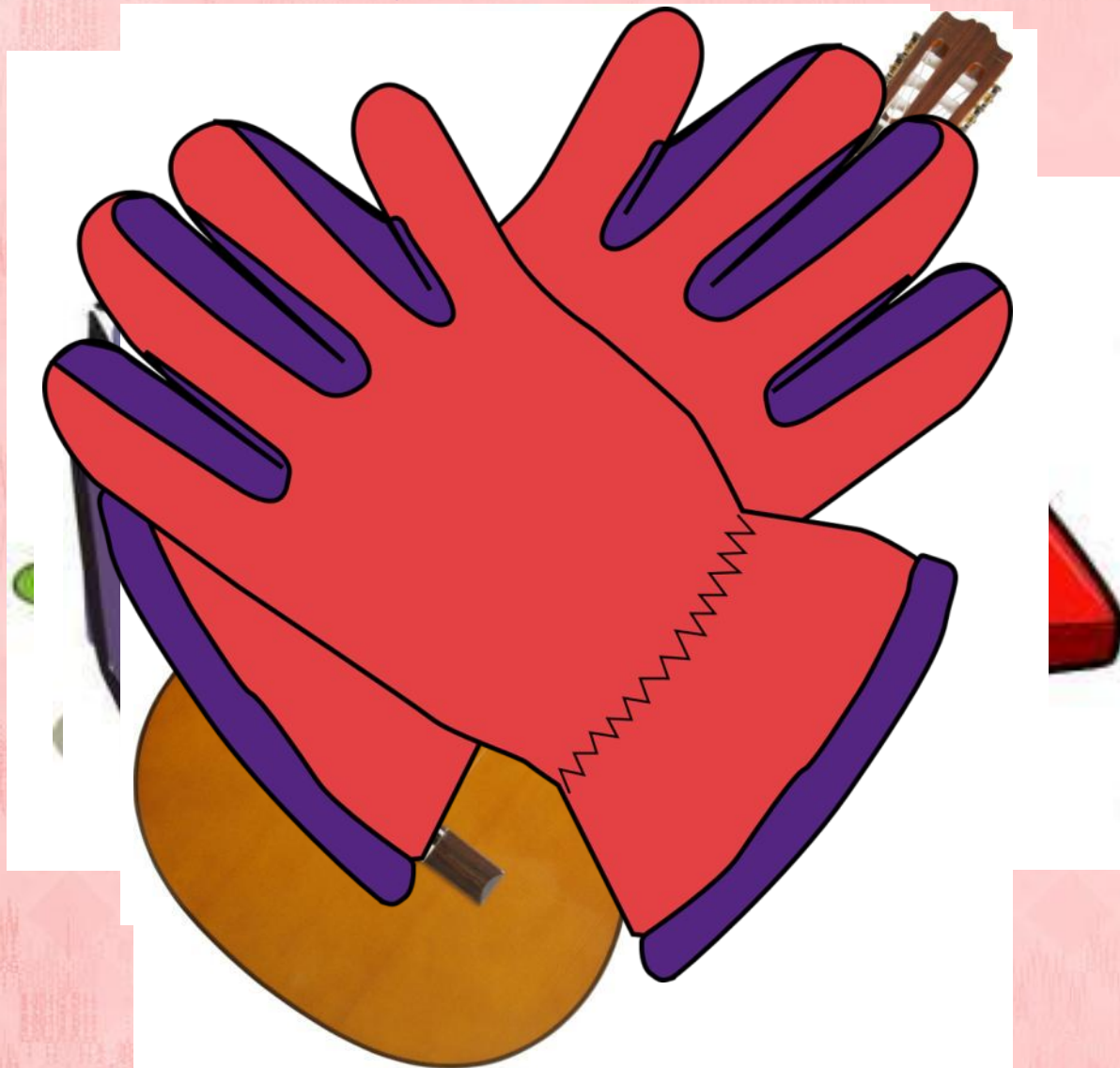

This / These - That / Those

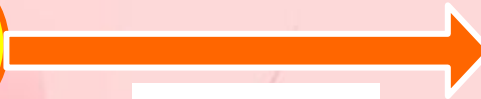
We use **this/these** for things near us.

We use **that/those** for things far from us.

We use **that** in the singular and **those** in the plural.

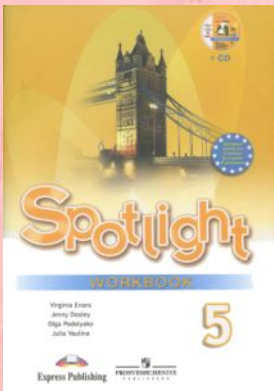
