

Perfect Continuous (завершенно – длительное)



- <u>Simple</u> факт, одноразовое или повторяющееся действие. Мы примерно знаем, когда оно произошло/произойдет.
- <u>Continuous</u> процесс, которые происходит/происходил/будет происходить в определенный момент в прошлом, сейчас, в будущем, и мы точно знаем, в какой. (предлог «В»)
- <u>Perfect</u> результат какого-то действия к определенному моменту в прошлом, к настоящему моменту или к моменту в будущем. (предлог «К»)
- <u>Perfect Continuous</u> действие/процесс, и мы знаем, с какого и до какого момента он длился, длится или будет длиться. (предлоги «с до»)
