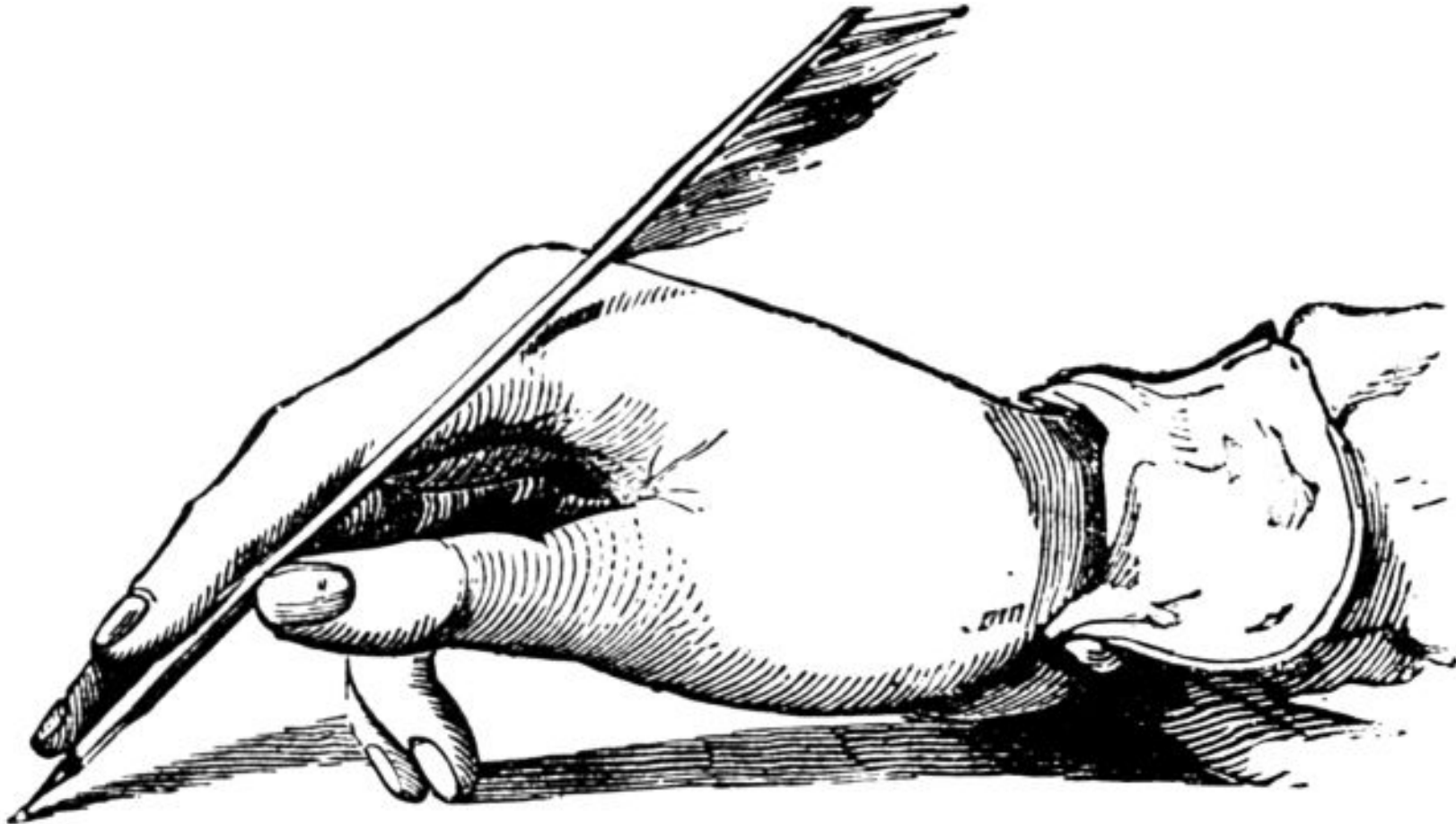

Thinke all but one, and me in that one *will*.

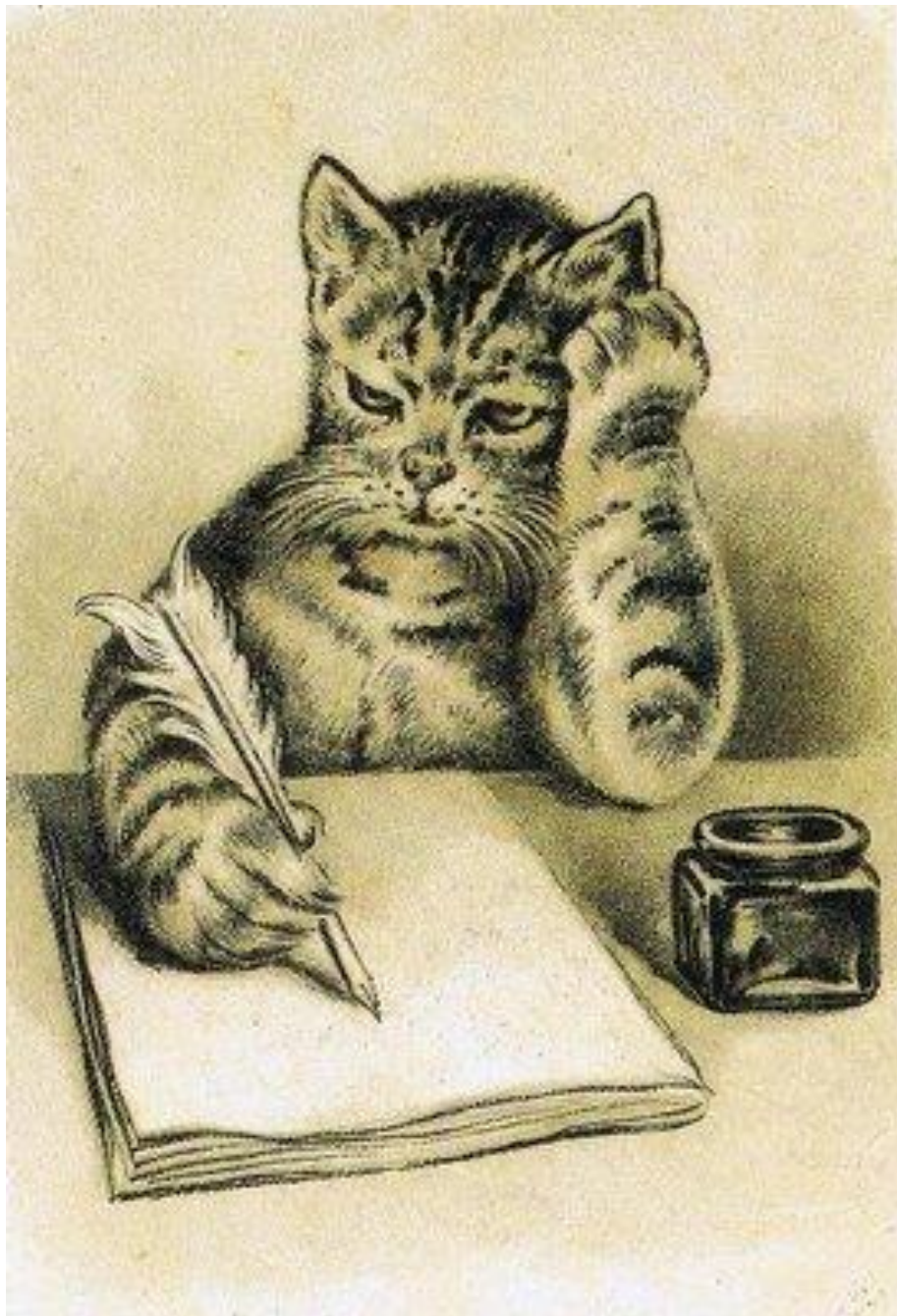
