Fast Facts: **The London Tube**

London has an underground train network called the Tube. It's one of the busiest in the world, and it's the oldest. The first tube train left Paddington Station in 1863, more than 150 years ago. The Tube was a lot cheaper then: a single journey cost six pence. Today it costs about £5.
