
# Altered mental status in a patient with known hypertension




65-year-old man, history revealed 20 years of hypertension, which was poorly controlled and smoking 1 to 2 packs of cigarettes per day for last 35 years





This middle aged lady presented 10 years following a successful ACOM berry aneurysm was clipped.





84-year-old man with a history of hypertension





50 year old male presenting with acute onset severe headache .
