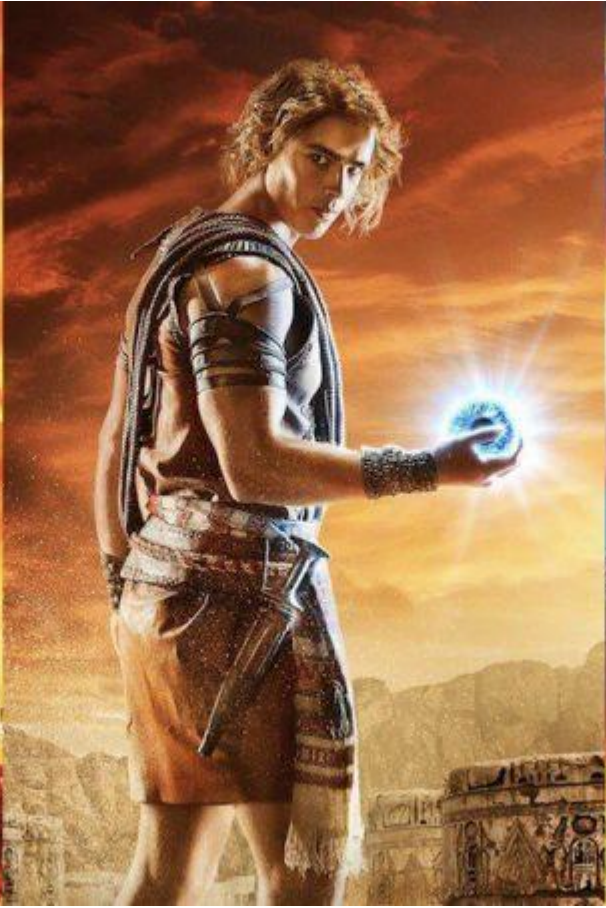
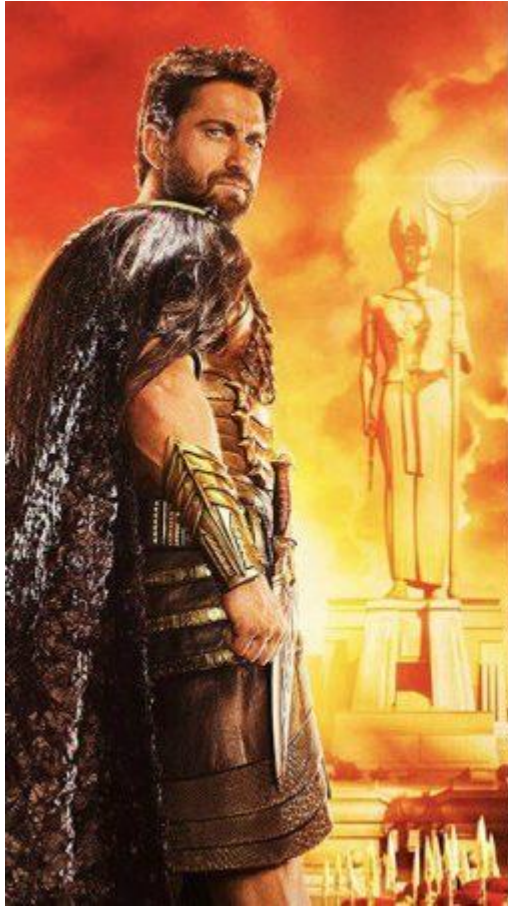
- I** Hi, Bella. This is your first show in London. How many models have you got here today?

- B** My models haven't got tattoos. I'm not into them.

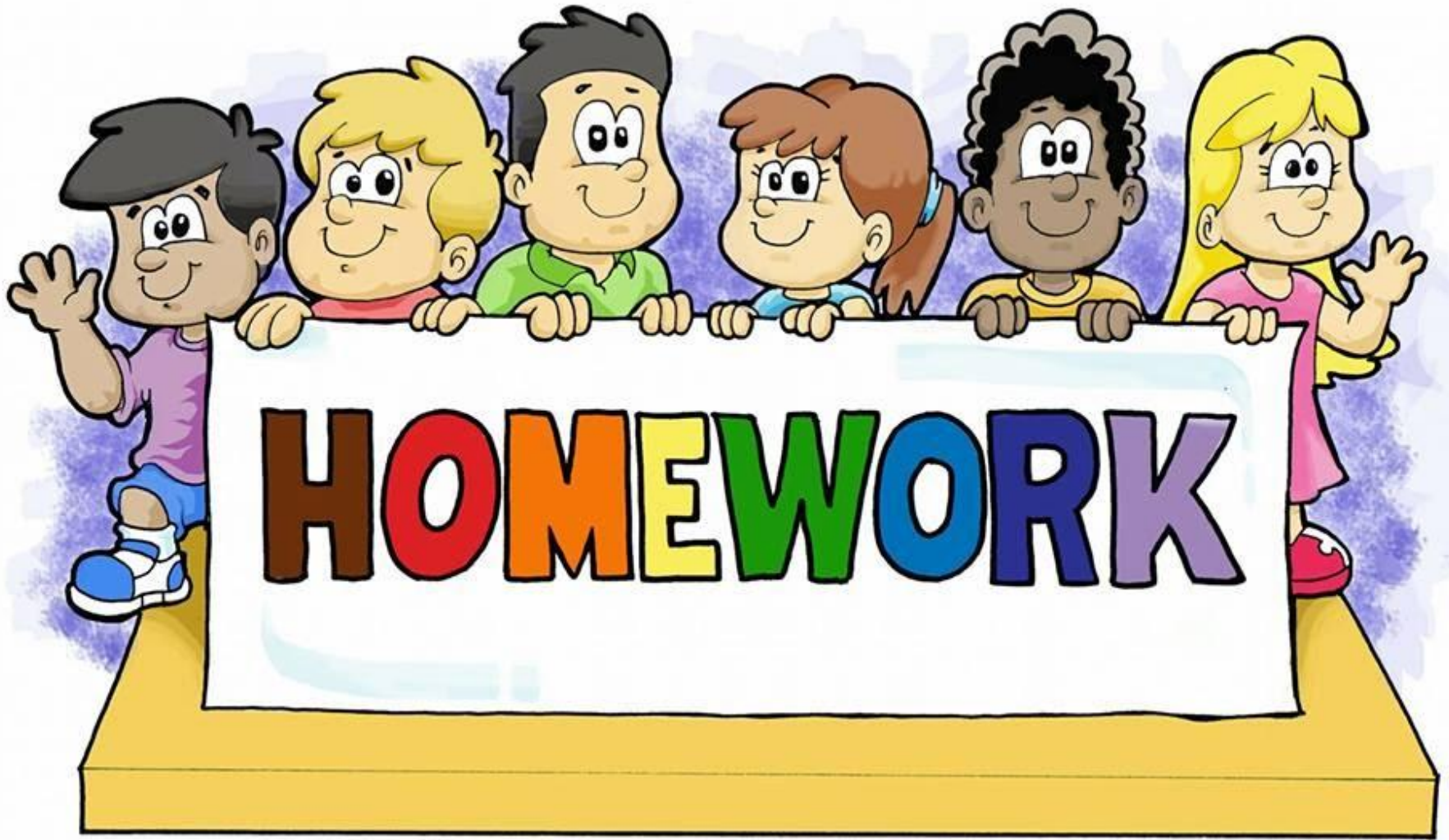
