NEGATIVE, INTERROGATIVE & MIXED FORMS

NEGATIVE FORM

- In the negative form there is no difference between regular and irregular verbs.
- We need an auxiliary verb: **DID** + not
did not = didn't
- After **didn't** we add the **infinitive** of the verb
He studied → He **didn't** study
I went → He **didn't** go

INTERROGATIVE & SHORT ANSWERS

- In the interrogative form we put **DID** in front of the subject.
- After the subject we use the **infinitive**.
- For short answer we use S+ **DID** or **DIDN'T**
Did you **buy** the book?
Yes, I **did**/ No, I **didn't**.
Did the children **study**?
Yes, they **did**/ No, they **didn't**.

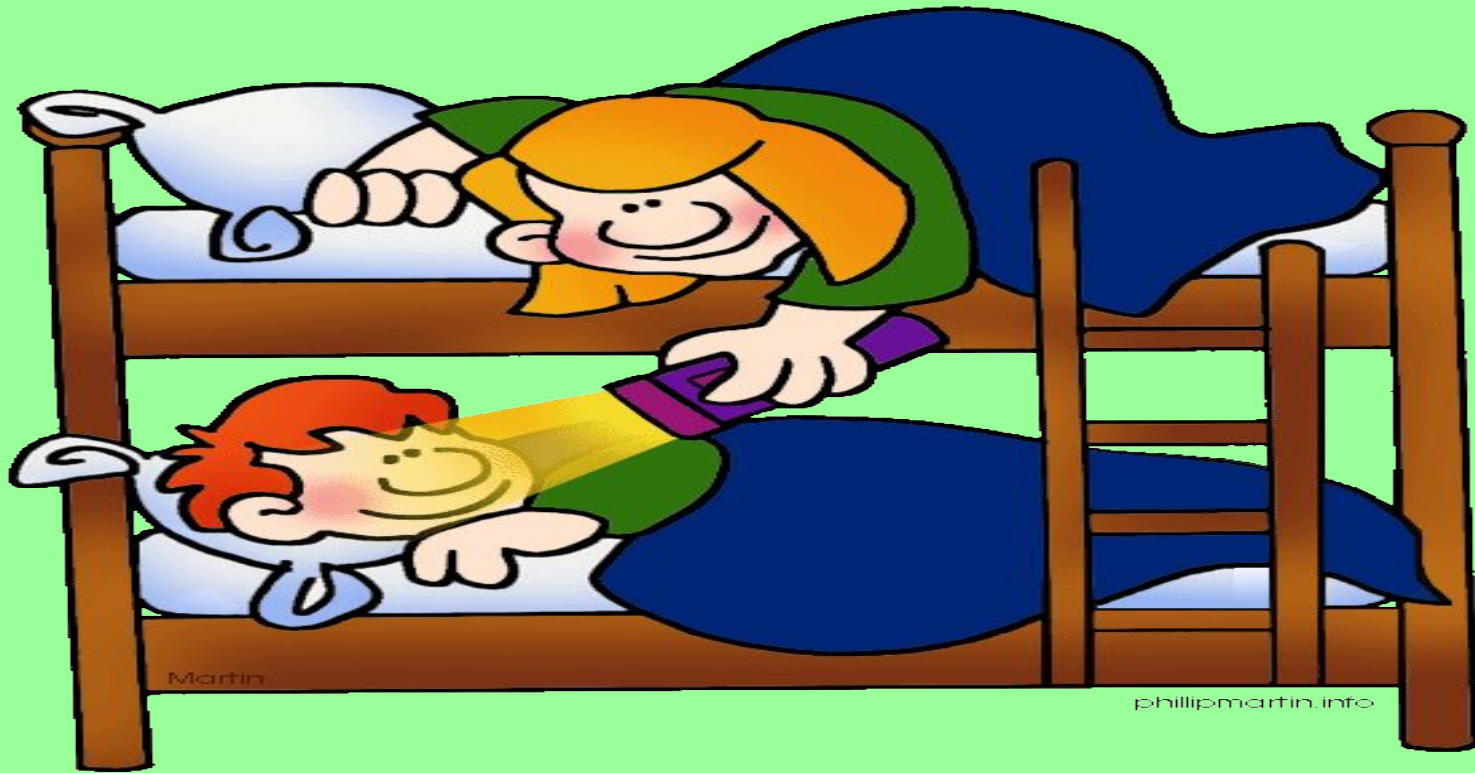
