
## Cathedral Mosque opened in the summer of 2007

#### The Eternal Flame Memorial Ensemble




The monument is a figure of a warrior-liberator holding a torch in the raised left hand - the symbol of Victory, with his left foot he rests on the Nazi helmet. Next to the warrior is a stele, the falling part of which symbolizes the life of the fallen soldiers, and the wing directed upwards means the continuation of the life of the townspeople - warriors.

Bayazitov -Tatar and Russian Muslim leader




## Monument to the Children of War
