

Present Perfect



His shoes are dirty.



He is cleaning his shoes.



He **has cleaned** his shoes.
(= his shoes are clean *now*)



They are at home.



They are going out.



They **have gone** out.
(= they are not at home *now*)

Образование:

To have + 3-я форма
СМЫСЛОВОГО ГЛАГОЛА

Have/has + Ved (V_3)

Случаи употребления:

- 1) Законченное действие, связанное с настоящим через результат, опыт или приобретённые знания.

He has written a book.

I have been to the USA.

He has read this book.

2) действие, начавшееся в прошлом и продолжающееся до сих пор, особенно с глаголами состояния (be, have, like, know, love, hate, feel):

- I have known her for eight years.
- She has loved him since childhood.
- How long have you been in Moscow?

3) совершившееся действие в период времени, который ещё не закончился (today, this morning, this week, this month, this year, this winter:

I have seen him this week.

I have been busy this afternoon.

Указатели времени, употребляемые с Present Perfect:

- - **already** (уже)
- I have already been to the gym.
- - **yet** (ещё не, уже в вопросах и отрицаниях)
- Have you joined the drama club yet?
- Steven hasn't come home yet.
- - **just** (только что)
- I have just finished my homework.
