We use the verb «to be» to say who somebody is or who somebody isn't and, in particular, to say what is our profession

Present tense of be

We use **be** to say who somebody is or what something is.

I'm Sam.

I am Sam.

You're/We're/They're from the UK.

You/ We/They are from the UK.

He's/She's a website developer.

He/She is a website developer.

It's in the US.

It is in the US.

We use **be** to ask personal questions.

Where are you from?

What's his name/job?

What is his name/job?

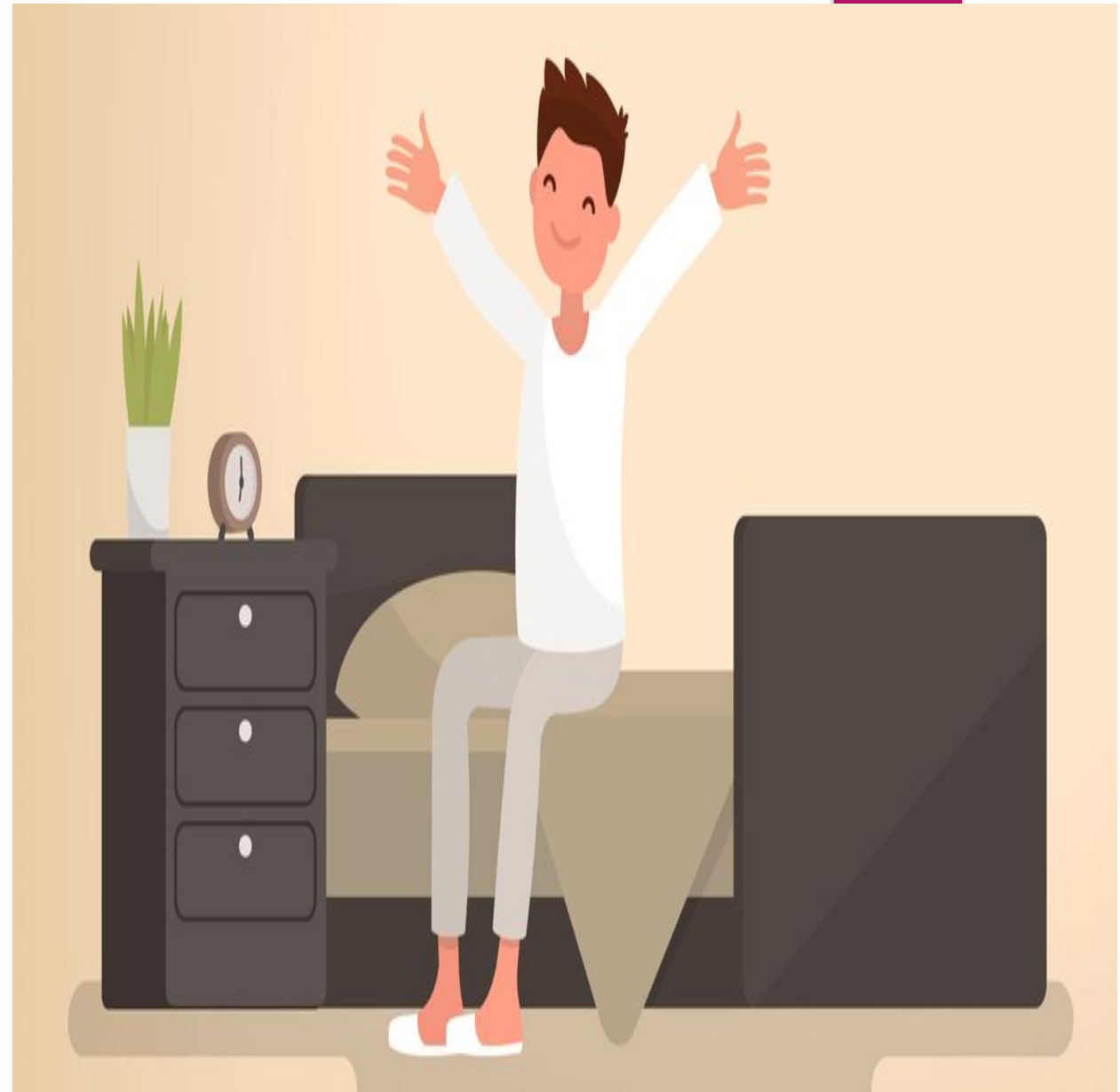

Present simple

We use the **present simple** to talk about routines and things that are permanent or happen all the time.

*What **do** you **do**? I'm a programmer.*

*What **does** she **do**? She's a developer.*

*Where **does** she **work**? She **works** for IBM in Poland. She **doesn't work** in Estonia.*

*Where **do** they **work**? They **work** for Siemens in Egypt.*

*Do you **work** in IT? Yes, I **do**/No I **don't**.*
