We use the verb «to be» to say who somebody is or who somebody isn't and, in particular, to say what is our profession

### Present tense of be

We use <b>be</b> to say who somebody is or what something is.	<i>I'm Sam.</i>	<i>I am Sam.</i>
	<i>You're/We're/They're from the UK.</i>	<i>You/ We/They are from the UK.</i>
	<i>He's/She's a website developer.</i>	<i>He/She is a website developer.</i>
	<i>It's in the US.</i>	<i>It is in the US.</i>
We use <b>be</b> to ask personal questions.	<i>Where are you from?</i>	
	<i>What's his name/job?</i>	<i>What is his name/job?</i>

*Glad to meet you.*

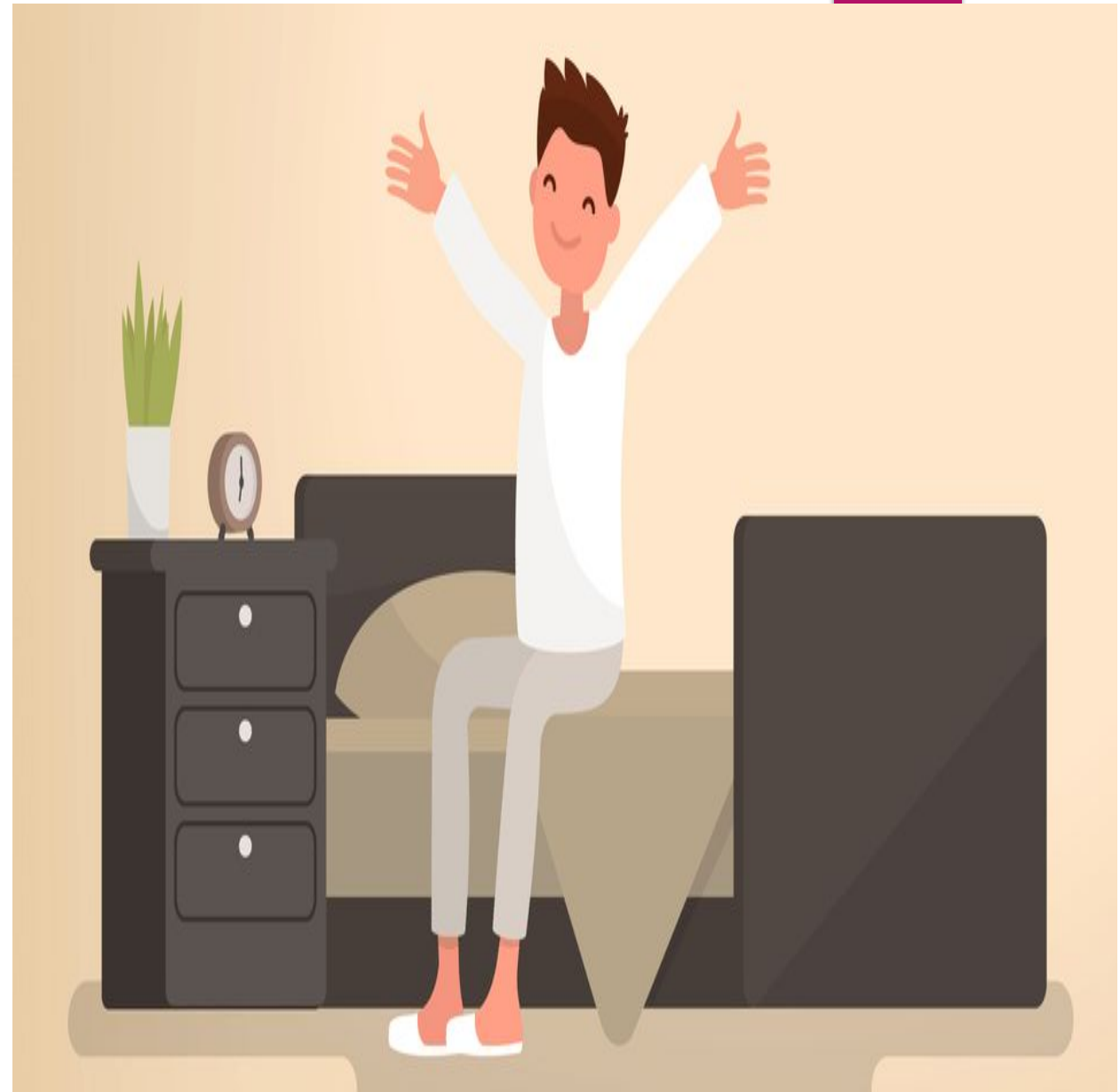
*Great seeing you.*

We use Present Simple to say that you usually do something (every day, every month, every week)





# «WHAT DO YOU DO?» — «I AM A PROGRAMMER!» THERE WE USE PRESENT SIMPLE TO SPEAK ABOUT PROFESSIONS

## Present simple

We use the **present simple** to talk about routines and things that are permanent or happen all the time.

*What **do you do**? I'm a programmer.*

*What **does she do**? She's a developer.*

*Where **does she work**? She **works** for IBM in Poland. She **doesn't work** in Estonia.*

*Where **do they work**? They **work** for Siemens in Egypt.*

*Do you **work in IT**? Yes, I **do**/No I **don't**.*
