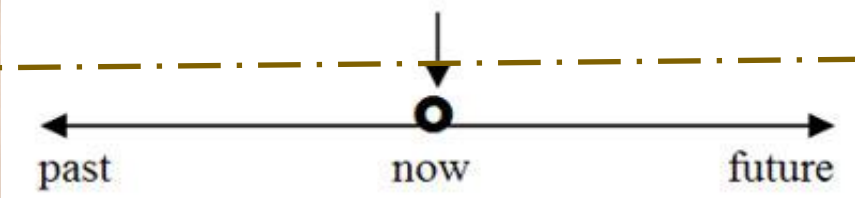

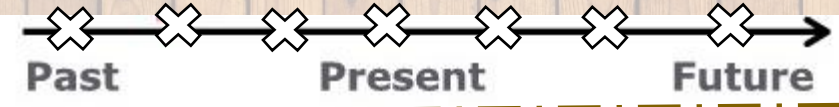
Look! The sergeant **is shouting** at my friend.

Present Continuous употребляется когда речь идет о действиях, происходящих в момент речи.

Present Simple употребляется когда речь идет о регулярных, постоянных действиях, привычках.

Present Continuous

at the moment

now

Put the verbs into the Present Simple or the Present Continuous:

- I usually play (play) in the yard after school. But now I am not playing (not play), I am doing (do) my homework.
- My father often shouts (shout) at me, but now he is not shouting (not shout) at me because he is sleeping (sleep).
- - Are you mopping (mop) the floor at the moment?
- No, I am not. I am talking (talk) to you now.
- All my friends walk (walk) in the park at the weekends. My best friend doesn't walk (not walk) so often because he is (be) very busy.
- - Look! A cat is running (run) after a dog! - It's strange. Dogs usually run (run) after cats.
- Does she cook (cook) cakes every Sunday?

Example

study → studying

do → doing

see → seeing

write → writing

smile → smiling

sit → sitting

run → running

Ho: sleep → sleeping

Die → dying

Lie → lying

Rule

Прибавляется -ing без изменений в орфографии.

Конечная -e убирается и добавляется -ing

Если перед последней согласной стоит краткий гласный звук, то согласная удваивается.

Если же гласный звук долгий - просто добавляется -ing.

"ie" заменяется на «u» и добавляется -ing.

Example

walk → walks

run → runs

see → sees

pass → pass**es**

fix → fix**es**

watch → watch**es**

study → studi**es**

try → tri**es**

Но: say → says

Rule

Прибавляется -s без изменений в орфографии.

- **es** прибавляется к глаголам, оканчивающимся на **-ss, -sh, -ch, -x, -o**

У глаголов, оканчивающихся на **согласную + "y"**, "y" опускается и добавляется **-ies**

Но к глаголам, оканчивающимся на **гласную + "y"**, прибавляется **-s**
