**-I'm going to **meet with my friends, go to the cinema or theatre or surf the Internet**.**

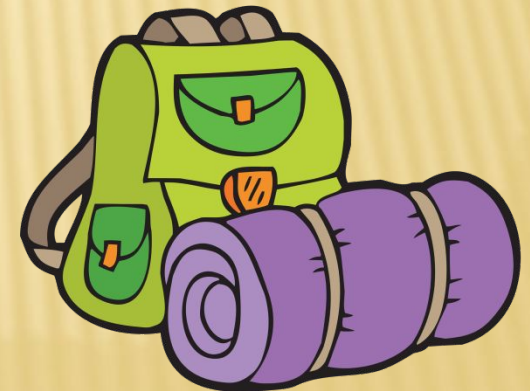

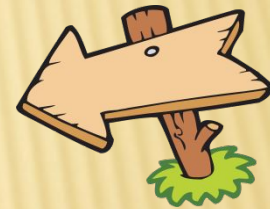
