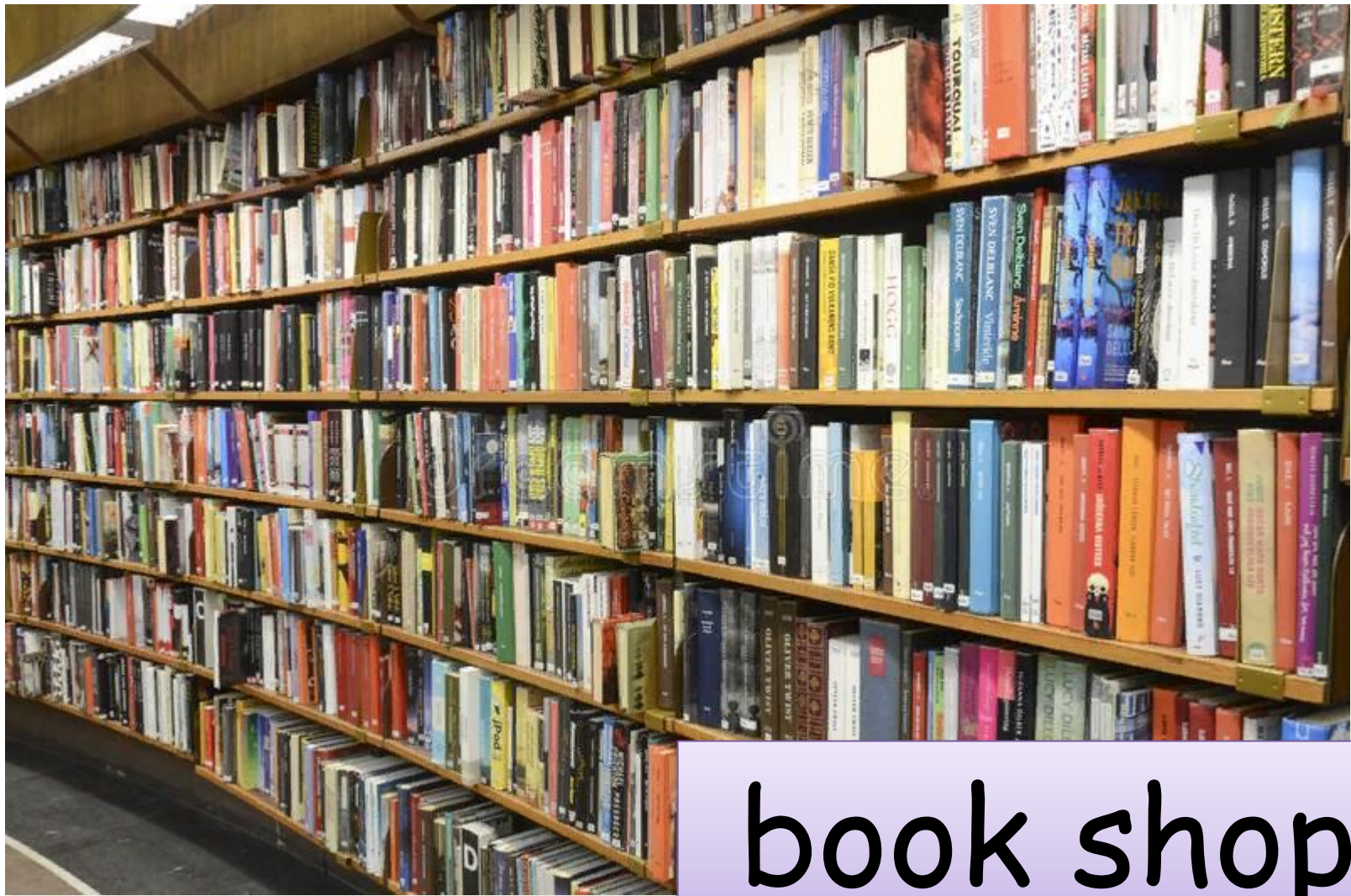

We use **a/an** with singular countable nouns when we mention something for the first time. We use **the** when it is clear which person/thing we mean. *Benny's is a shoe shop. The shoe shop is next to Karen's.*
