

STEREOTYPES ABOUT PEOPLE WITH DISABILITIES

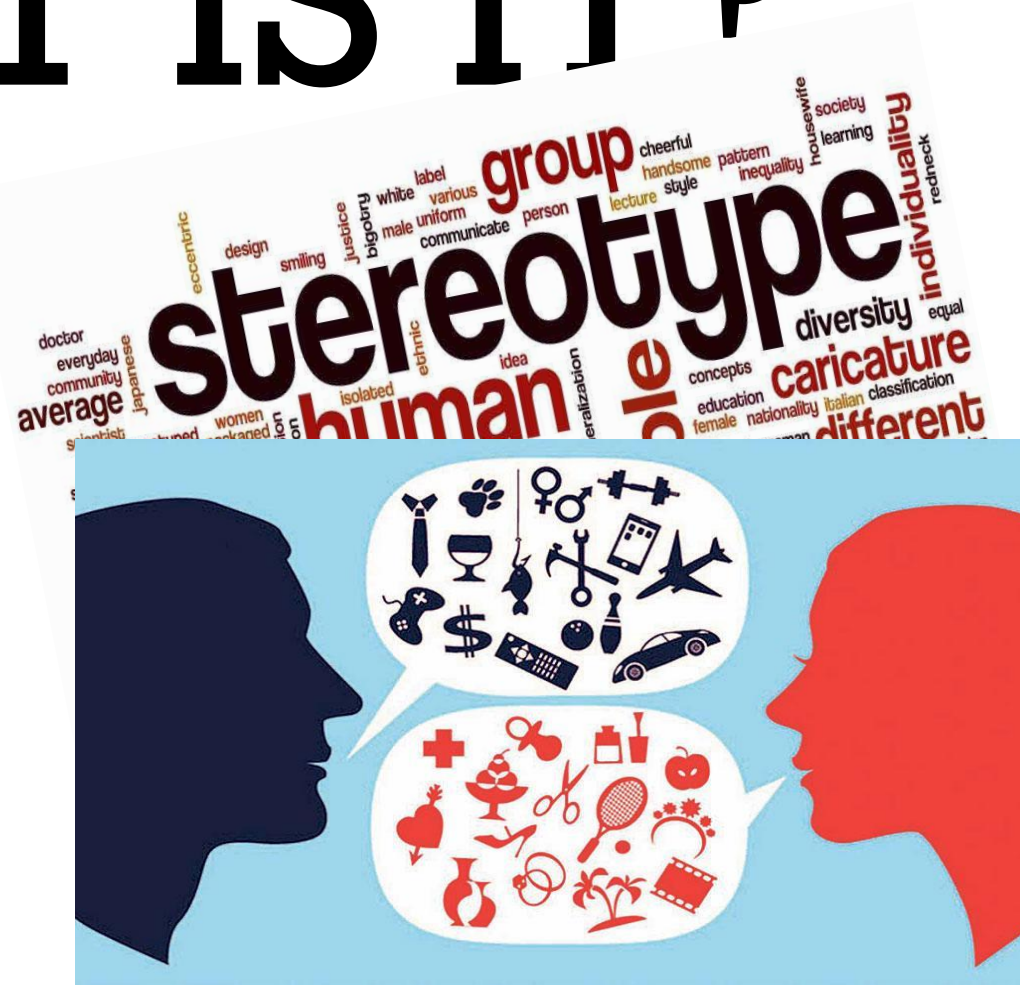
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WHAT IS IT?

Stereotype -- a person's pre-formed mental assessment of something, which can be reflected in the corresponding stereotypical behavior.

The concept of "stereotype" entered the socio-political Western discourse with the light hand of Walter Lippman, which he applied in describing his original concept of public opinion in 1922.



STEREOTYPE

- ***People with disabilities have a poor quality of life.***

People with disabilities have the same needs as those who are not disabled and they are just as committed to high standards of quality of life as other people.

- ***People with disabilities should live in boarding schools or rehabilitation centers under constant supervision.***

People with disabilities can live in their own home if there is a system of care and treatment.

- ***Because of the opinion in society, disabled people try not to leave the house, because they are afraid of being judged and slanted looks from others.***

People with disabilities should not avoid social life. They have every right to visit cultural places and are not afraid to be in public places.



STEREOTYPE

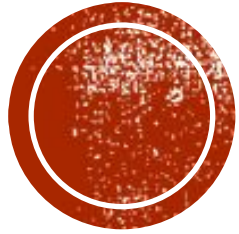
- **Many people in modern society are afraid of people with disabilities because of the fear of infection.**
