- 3 Diane, could you please give the tests? (distribute)
- 4 Sorry, I've forgotten to give you your dictionary! (return)
- 5 I've given all my textbooks from last year. (give sth because you no longer want it)


tem ● per BrE / 'tempə(r) / noun
[countable] the way that you are feeling at a particular time
mood BrE / muːd / noun
1 [countable] the way you are feeling at a particular time

Compound Nouns

Compound nouns are nouns that are made of two or more parts and are formed as follows:

- noun + noun. The plural is usually formed by adding -s/-es to the second noun.
 - e.g. bus driver bus drivers
- -ing form/adjective + noun. The plural is formed by adding -s/-es to the noun.
 - e.g. rocking-horse → rocking-horses
 dining room → dining rooms
 darkroom → darkrooms
- noun + In-law. The plural is formed by adding -s to the noun. e.g. brother-in-law brothers-in-law
- noun + adverb. The plural is formed by adding -s to the noun. e.g. passer-by = passers-by
- verb + adverb particle. The plural is formed by adding -s to the word.
 - e.g. breakdown breakdowns
