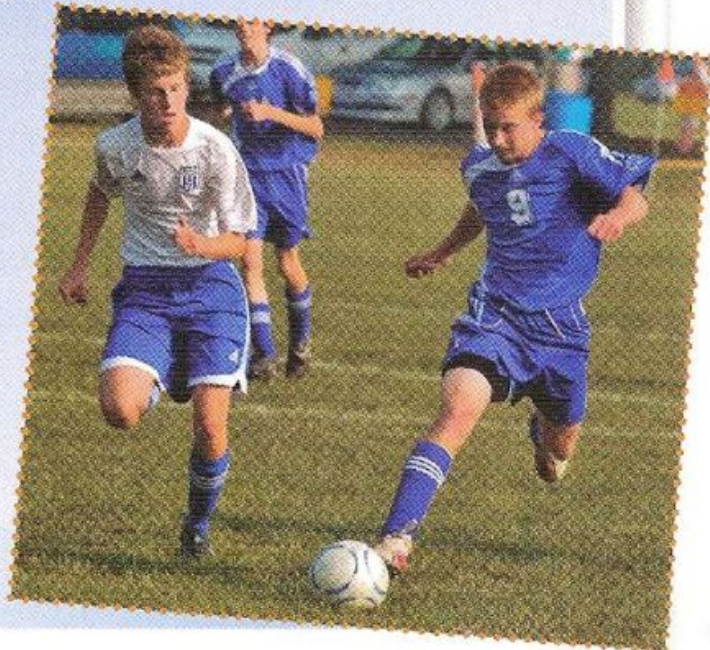
Hi Tom,

## Affirmative

I	'm (am)	going to read an ebook at the weekend.
You/We/They	're (are)	
He/She/It	's (is)	

## Negative

I	'm not (am not)	going to use IM this evening.
You/We/They	aren't (are not)	
He/She/It	isn't (is not)	

## Questions and short answers

Am	I	going to buy a laptop tomorrow?
Are	you/we/they	
Is	he/she/it	

Yes, I am. / No, I'm not.

Yes, you/we/they are. / No, you/we/they aren't.

Yes, he/she/it is. / No, he/she/it isn't.



### Watch Out!

Use *be going to* with these expressions:  
tomorrow / next week / next month / next year / soon
