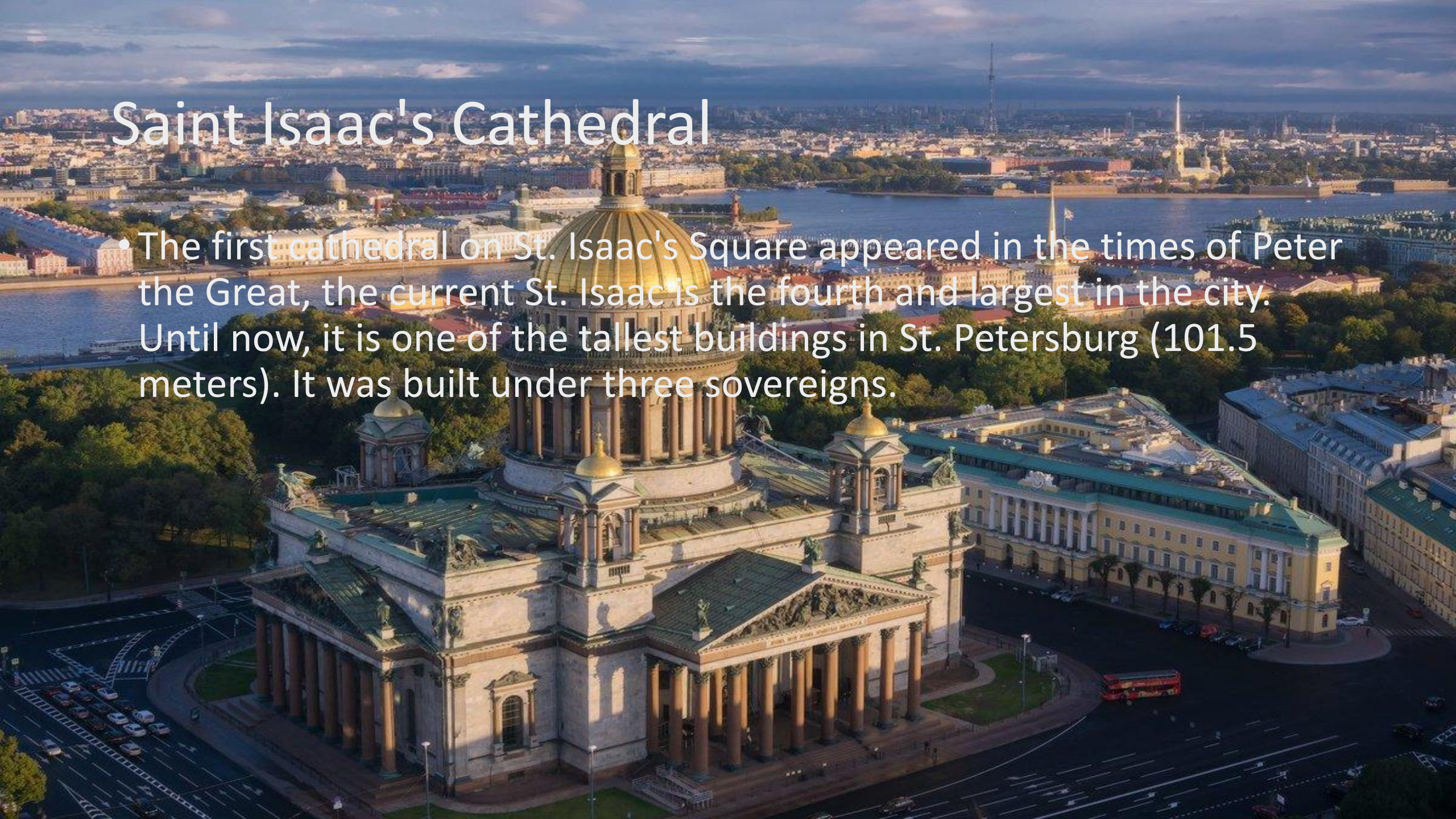

Saint Isaac's Cathedral

- The first cathedral on St. Isaac's Square appeared in the times of Peter the Great, the current St. Isaac is the fourth and largest in the city. Until now, it is one of the tallest buildings in St. Petersburg (101.5 meters). It was built under three sovereigns.





Hermitage and Palace Square

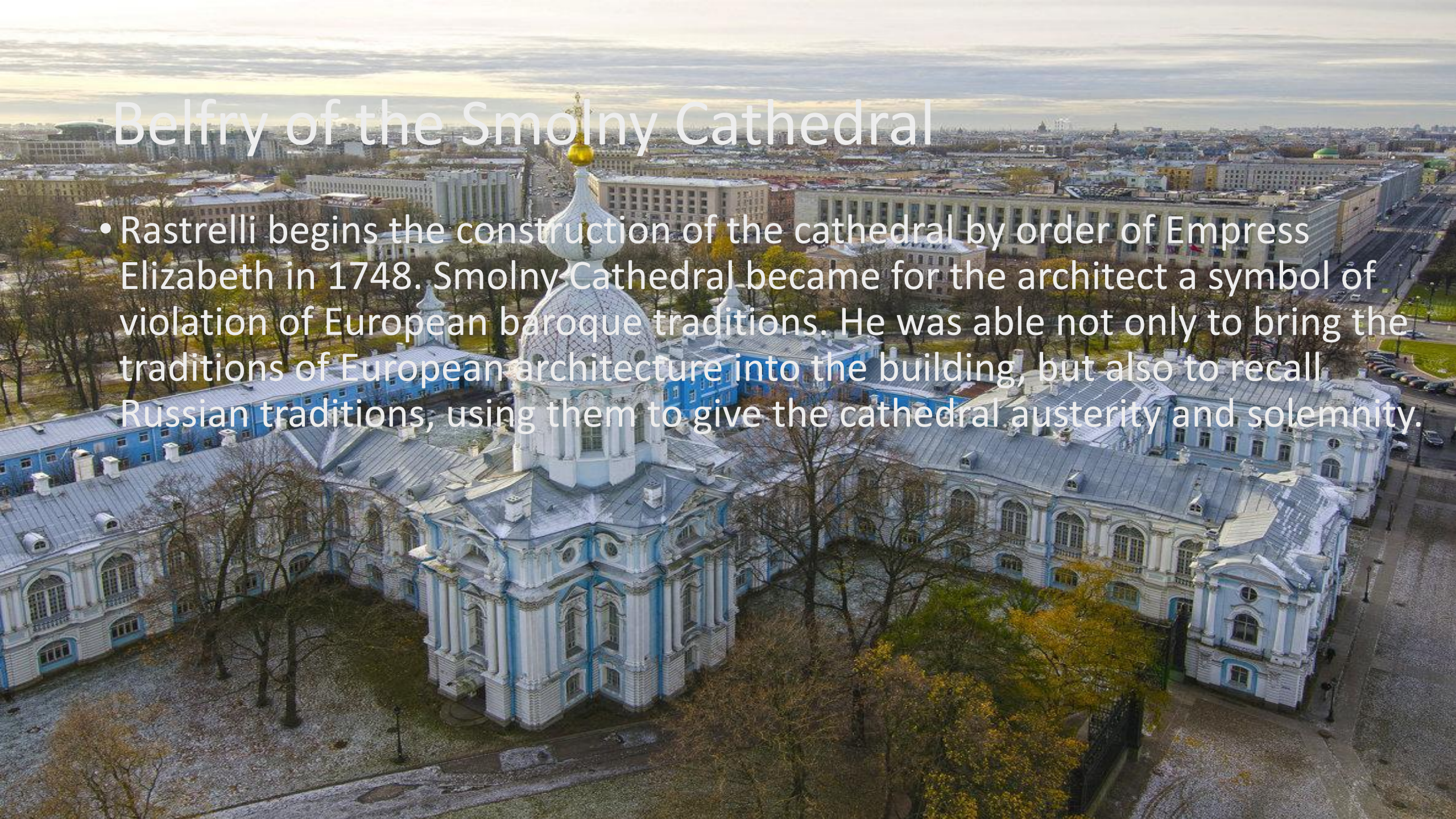

Belfry of the Smolny Cathedral

- Rastrelli begins the construction of the cathedral by order of Empress Elizabeth in 1748. Smolny Cathedral became for the architect a symbol of violation of European baroque traditions. He was able not only to bring the traditions of European architecture into the building, but also to recall Russian traditions, using them to give the cathedral austerity and solemnity.

- In Soviet times, this cruiser was better known as a symbol of revolution, and now people come here to look at a colorful exposition dedicated to one of the most tragic pages in the history of the Russian fleet - the history of the beginning of the 20th century: its crew witnessed all the sad events that befell Russia in those times
