The International Space Station – Expedition One

1 When was the first expedition to the space station?

It was in 2000. The start of the mission was on 31st October. People around the world were excited because it was an international challenge.

2 Who were the astronauts?

There were three men in the crew – American, William Shepherd, and Russians, Sergei Krikalev and Yuri Gidzenko. Shepherd was the commander.

3 How long was their stay?

The first crew were on the International Space Station for 136 days, nearly four months.

4 What was life like?

There was oxygen, water and food, of course, but the station wasn't very comfortable and there wasn't a lot of room. The men weren't bored because there was a lot of work – preparing the station, building equipment and doing experiments.

5 Were there any problems?

Yes, there were. There were some problems with the equipment. The crew were often tired. There were only two beds for the three men! It was very noisy and having a shower was impossible!

6 Was the return journey successful?

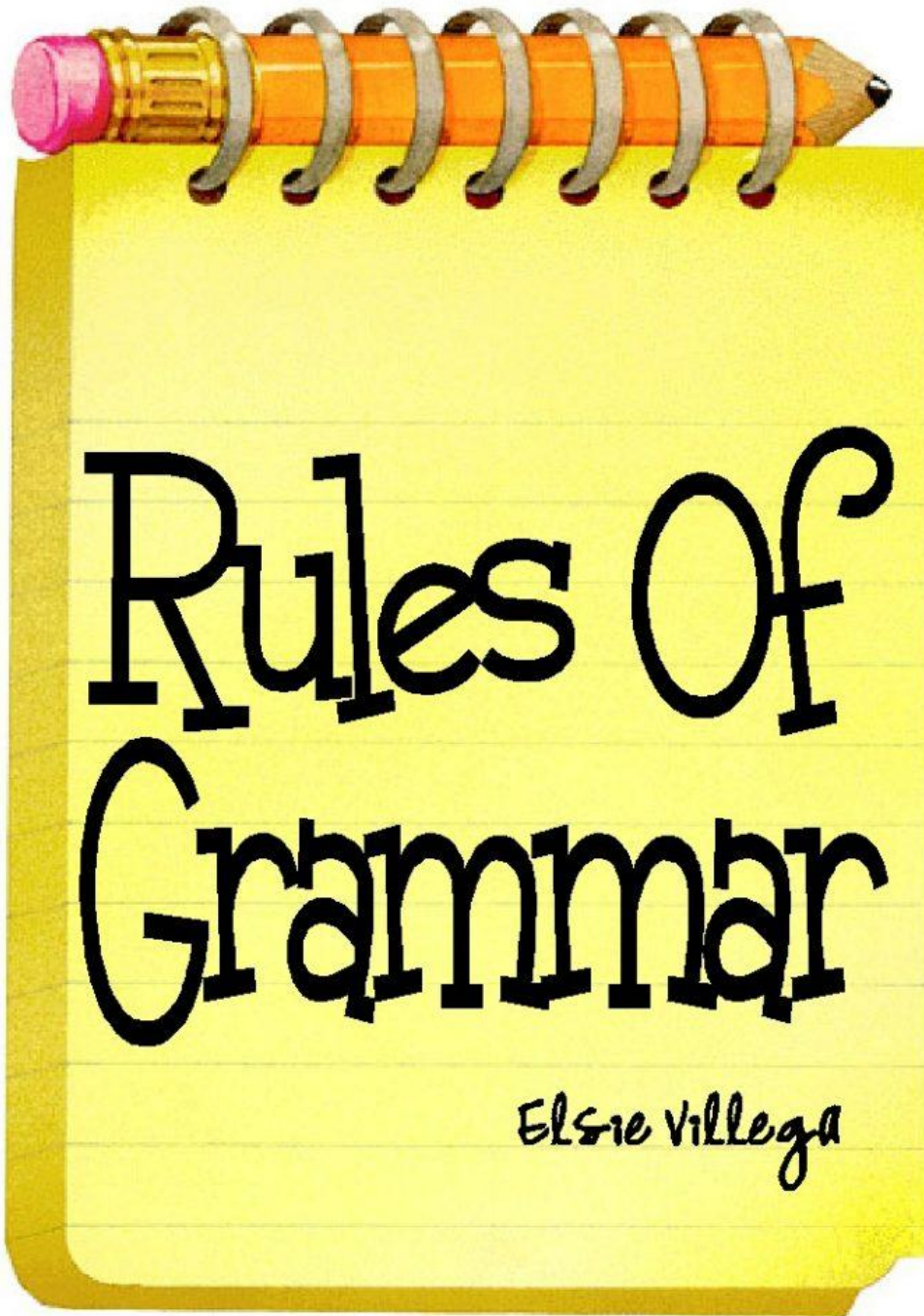
Yes, it was. There weren't any big problems and on 21st March, 2001 the crew of Expedition One were back on Earth. People were very interested in their mission.
