

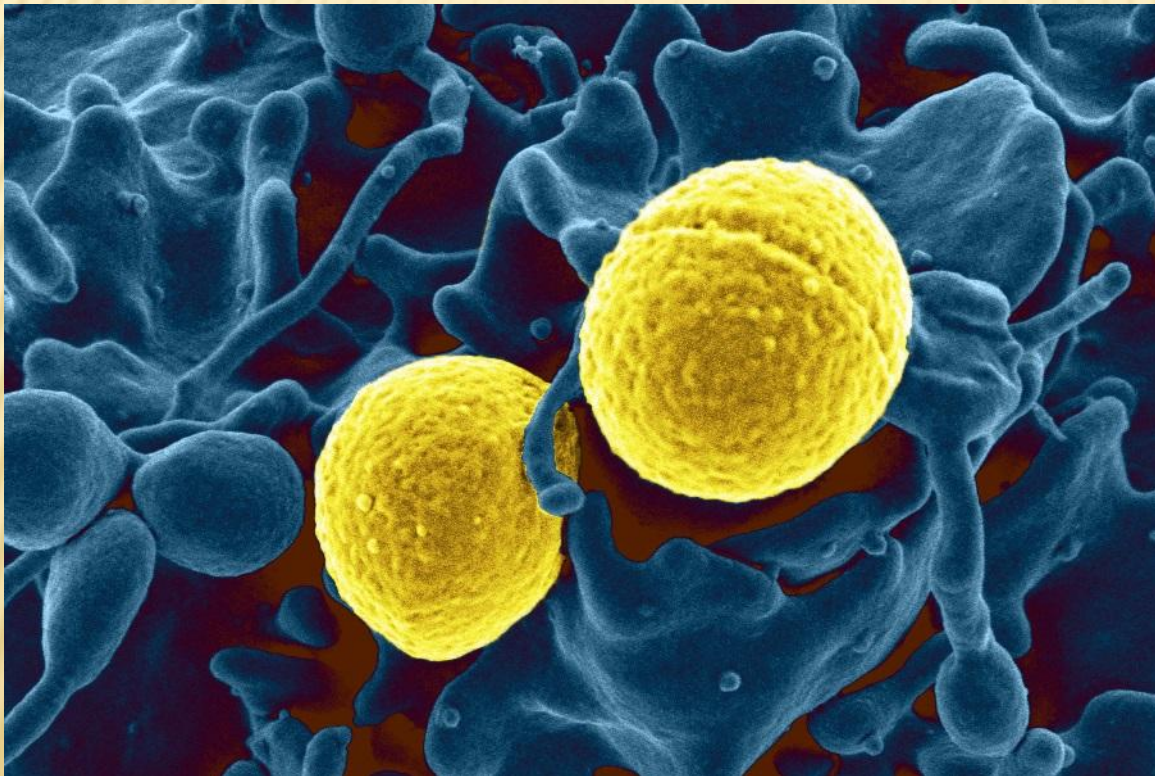

MARROW**

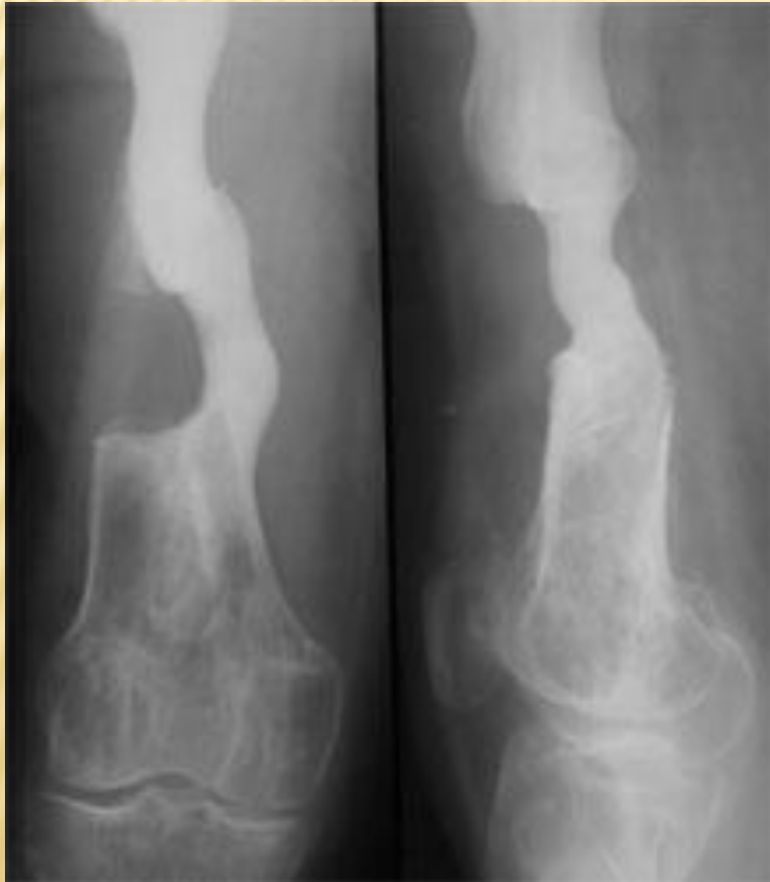


# SYMPTOMS
