






**OSTEOMYELITIS DEVELOPS AS A RESULT

MARROW**




SYMPTOMS

THE FIRST DAY, THERE IS A FEVER, THE TEMPERATURE RISES TO 40 ° C, THE PULSE QUICKENS



**ON THE THIRD DAY THERE IS PAIN OVER
THE AFFECTED AREAS, RESTRICTION OF
MOVEMENT AND SOFT TISSUE
SWELLING LIMBS, SKIN REDNESS**



SURGICAL TREATMENT IS THE REHABILITATION OF PURULENT FOCUS (OPENING AND DRAINAGE OF PURULENT CAVITIES)
