# When is it used?

- when a short action will be completed by a certain point in the future

**By Monday** I **will have done** all my homework.

We **will have prepared** the dinner **by the time** you arrive.

Answer the questions.

**Example:**

- **Have you repaired the bike yet?**
- **No, I'll have repaired it by Monday.**



- Have you sent the letter yet?
- No, by Friday.



- Have you checked your mailbox yet?
- **No, in a few hours.**




- Have you done your homework yet?
- No, by Monday.



- Have you solved the task yet?

- No, by tomorrow.

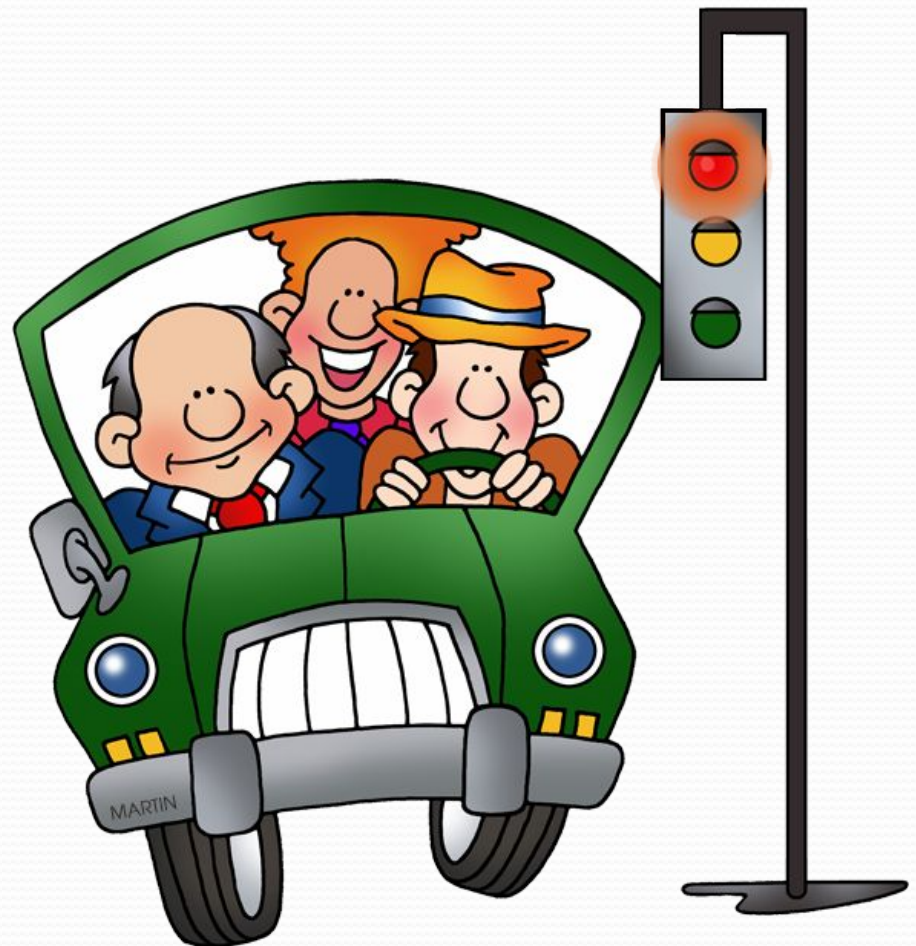

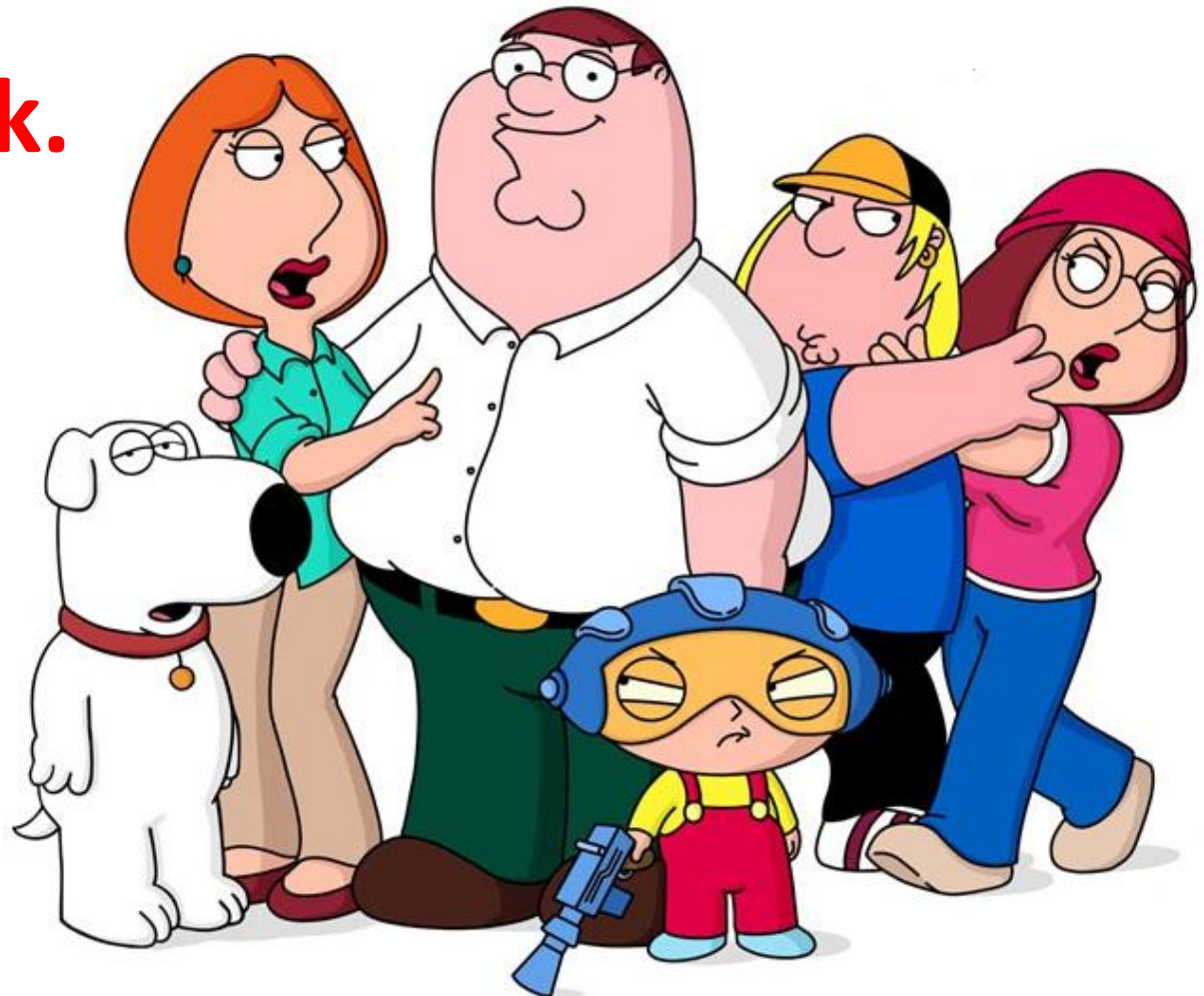
