WHAT ARE HOUSES LIKE?

Most houses in England are made of stone or brick from the local area where the houses are built. The colours of the stones and bricks vary across the country



TYPES OF HOUSES IN ENGLAND

- **A detached house**

A detached house is not joined to any other



TYPES OF HOUSES IN ENGLAND

- **A semi-detached house**

A semi detached house is a house which is joined to another house on one side.



TYPES OF HOUSES IN ENGLAND

• A terraced house

Terrace house is a house which is part of a line of houses. It is a house which is joined to other houses on two sides



TYPES OF HOUSES IN ENGLAND

- **A block of flats**

A flat is part of a bigger building where all the flats share a front door.



TYPES OF HOUSES IN ENGLAND

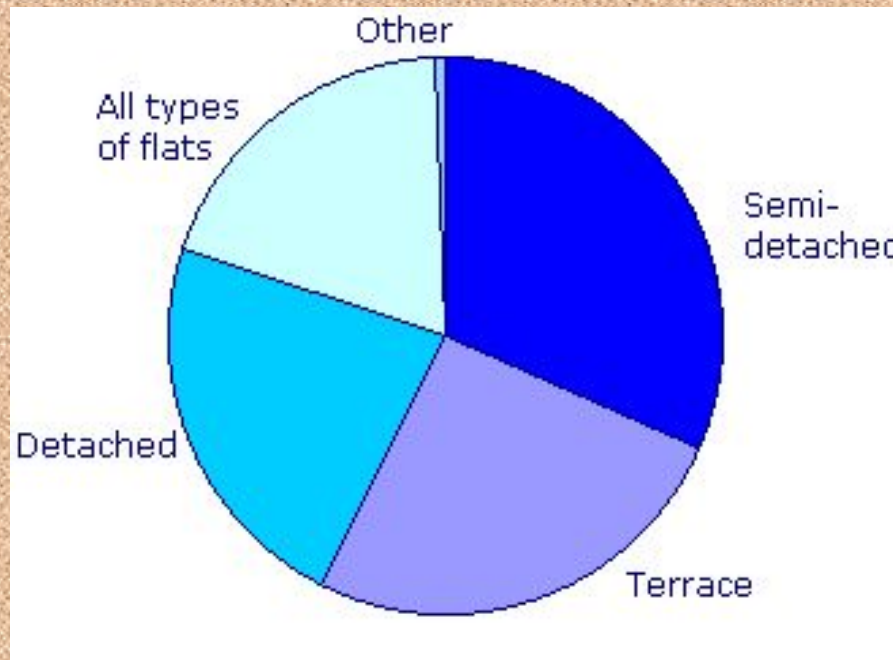
• A Bungalow

A bungalow is a house which is only on one floor, no stairs. It may be joined to another bungalow or might stand alone.



TYPES OF HOUSES IN ENGLAND

- The **most popular type of home** in England is semi-detached (more than 27% of all homes), closely followed by detached then terraced
