- 1997 published the first 'Reference book for the homeless'
- 2000 launched a rehab project, 'Halfway Home'
- 2002 launched the Night Bus project
- 2005 opened the city's largest rehabilitation shelter for the homeless on Borovaya
- 2007 started running a second Night Bus
- 2012 organized NochlezhkaFest
- 2013 ran a campaign in the Summer Garden
- 2016 held International conference on assistance to homeless people in St. Petersburg
