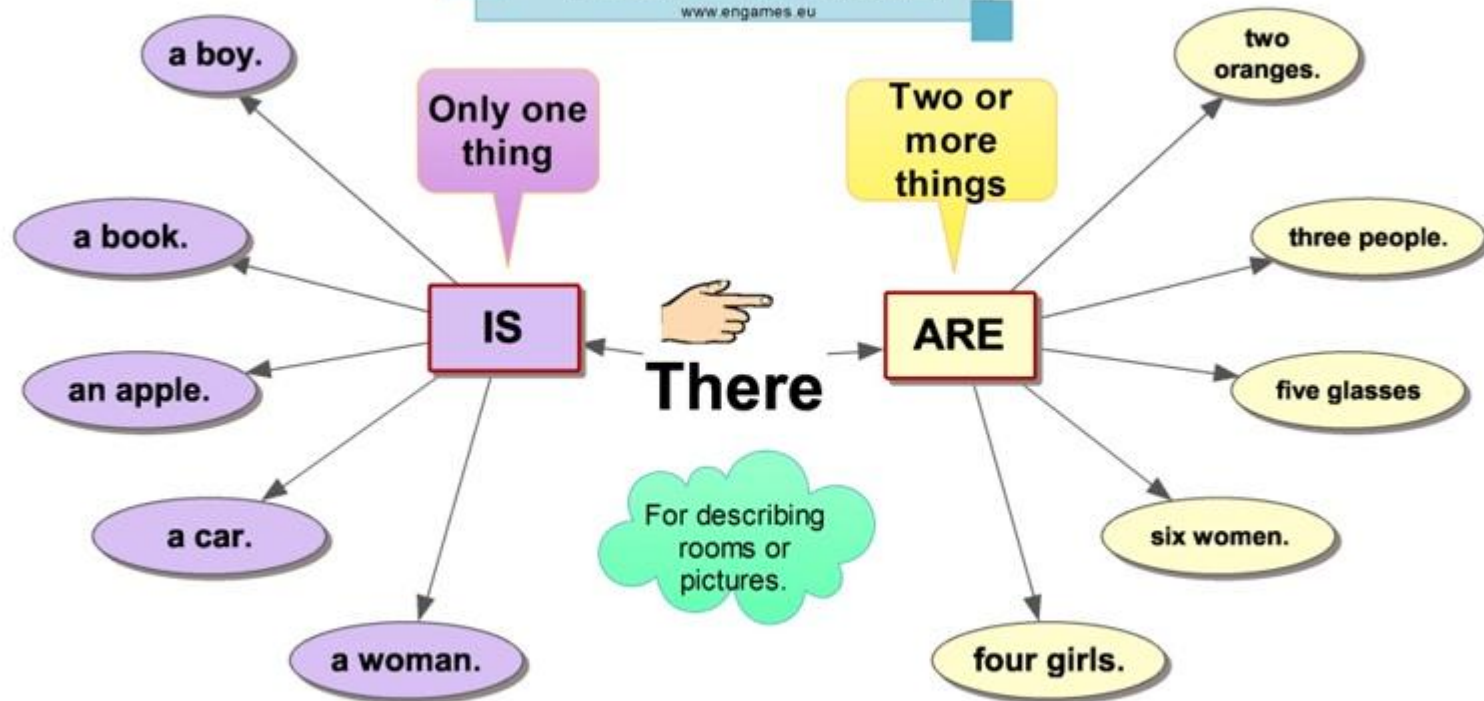

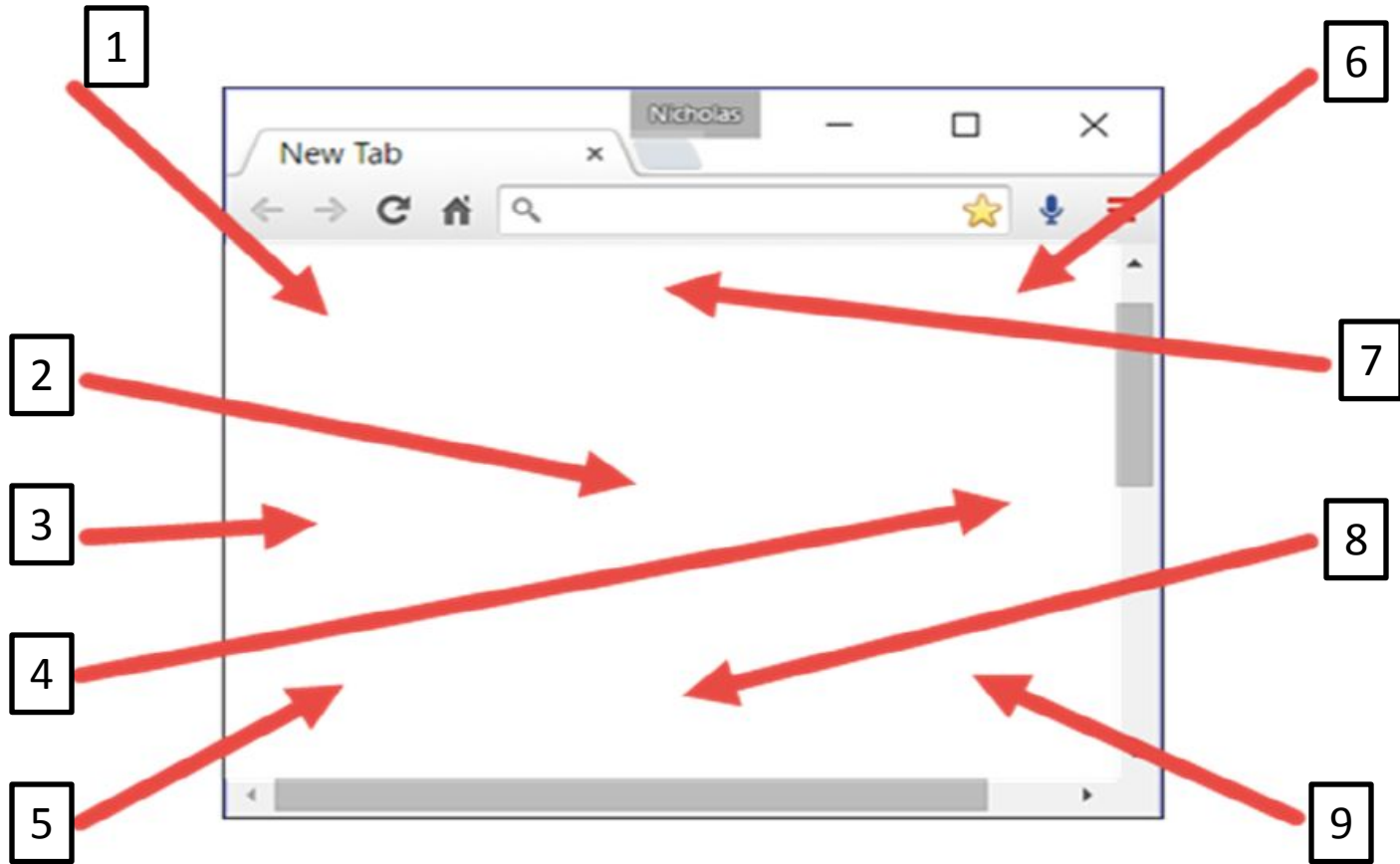

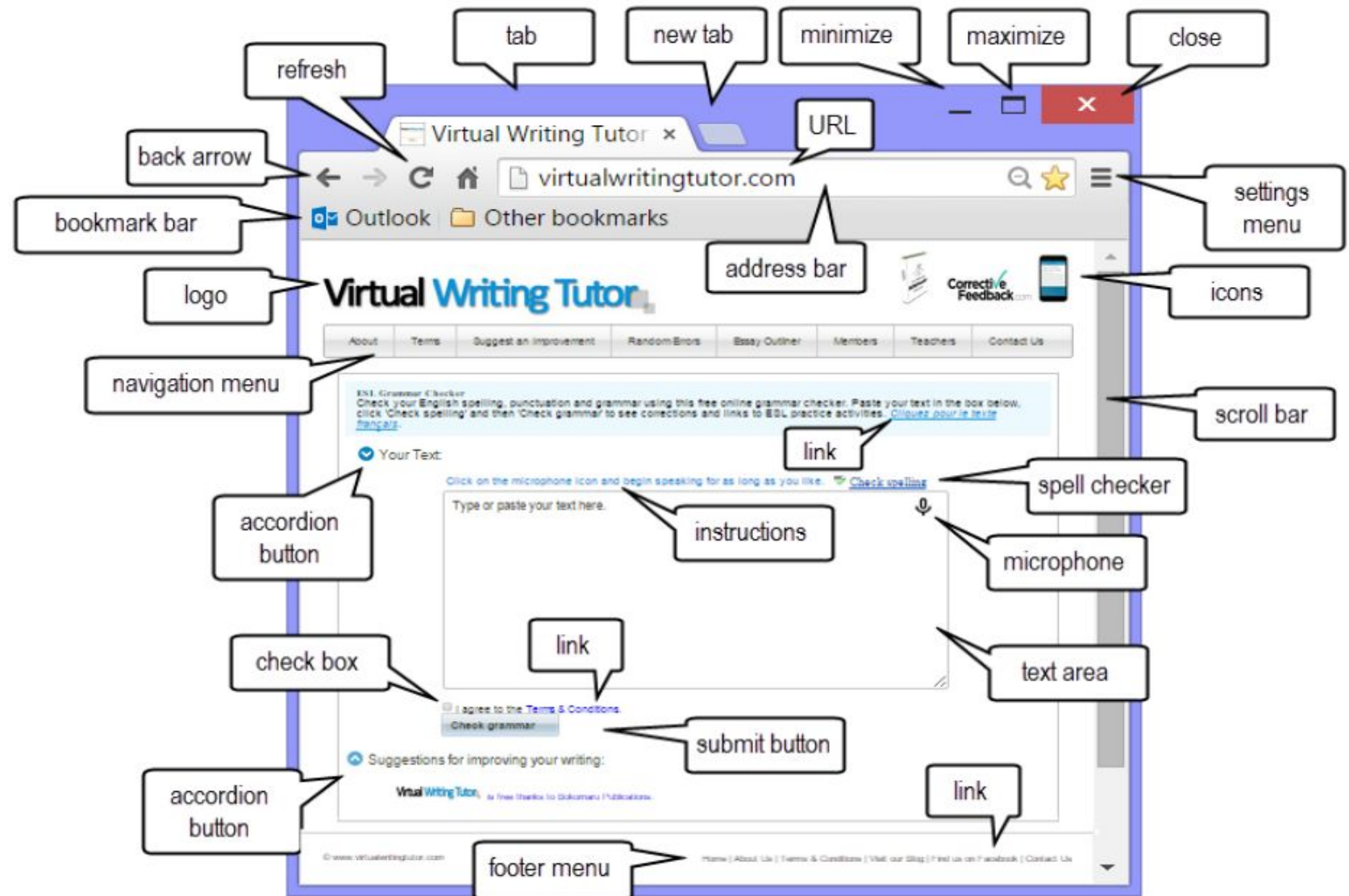

Present Simple Passive

В английском языке существует два типа залога: активный (Active Voice) и пассивный (Passive Voice). В активном залоге подлежащее обозначает лицо или предмет, которое совершает действие, а глагол употребляется в форме действительного залога. В пассивном (страдательном) залоге действие направлено на лицо, выраженное подлежащим.

She reads a book. – Она читает книгу (активный залог).

The book is read. – Книгу читают (пассивный залог).

Пассивный (страдательный) залог в простом настоящем времени (Present Simple) образуется с помощью глагола to be + III форма основного глагола. Ниже представлена таблица образования Present Simple Active and Passive :

Present Simple Active	Present Simple Passive	Пример употребления
ask/asks	am is asked are	Mike asks a lot of questions about the book. – Майк задает много вопросов о книге. A lot of questions are asked about the book. – Много вопросов задают о книге.
